## **HOUSE BILL No. 5338**

February 10, 2016, Introduced by Reps. Vaupel, Barrett, Kosowski and Lucido and referred to the Committee on Military and Veterans Affairs.

A bill to amend 1994 PA 39, entitled "Veteran right to employment services act," by amending section 2 (MCL 35.1092).

Sec. 2. As used in this act:

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

2	(a) "Armed forces" means the army, air force, navy, marine
3	corps, coast guard, or other military force designated by congress
4	as a part of the armed forces of the United States.
5	(A) (b) "Employment services" means referrals to employers,
6	supportive services, or assistance in finding employment training.
7	(B) (c) "Job training services" means any program that
8	provides training or training services to eligible applicants.
9	(C) (d) "Veteran" means any of the following:
LO	(i) A person who served on active duty in the armed forces for
L1	a period of more than 180 days and separated from the armed forces

- 1 in a manner other than a dishonorable discharge.
- 2 (ii) A person discharged or released from active duty because
- 3 of a service related disability.
- 4 (iii) A member of a reserve branch of the armed forces at the
