## **HOUSE BILL No. 5351**

February 10, 2016, Introduced by Rep. Kosowski and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to create the school security task force; and to prescribe the powers and duties of the school security task force.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "school security task force act".
- 3 Sec. 3. As used in this act:
- 4 (a) "School shooting incident" means a mass shooting event
  - involving an attack by an individual or individuals armed with
- firearms on an educational institution in which the educational
  - institution is the location for the attack.
- (b) "Task force" means the school security task force created
- 9 in section 5.

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- 1 Sec. 5. (1) The school security task force is created within
- 2 the department of state police.
- 3 (2) The governor shall appoint members to the task force in
- 4 consultation with the director of the department of state police.
- 5 The task force shall be made up of 5 individuals and shall include
- 6 the following:
- 7 (a) The director of the department of state police.
- 8 (b) The director of the department of military and veterans
- 9 affairs or his or her designee.
- (c) The director of the department of health and human
- 11 services or his or her designee.
- 12 (d) Two individuals appointed by the governor.
- 13 (3) The director of the department of state police shall serve
- 14 as the task force's presiding officer. The task force shall meet at
- 15 the call of the presiding officer.
- 16 (4) The task force shall make recommendations for improving
- 17 school policies and procedures in response to school shooting
- 18 incidents in this state. In making those recommendations, the task
- 19 force shall do all of the following:
- 20 (a) Gather information concerning school shooting incidents
- 21 throughout this state.
- 22 (b) Receive reports and testimony from individuals, state and
- 23 local agencies, community-based organizations, and other public and
- 24 private organizations.
- 25 (c) Review policies and procedures developed in other states
- 26 to improve the school response to school shooting incidents.
- 27 (d) Create goals for school policies and procedures statewide

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- 1 to prevent school shooting incidents.
- 2 (e) Create recommendations and guidelines for school policies
- 3 and procedures for response to school shooting incidents.
- 4 (f) Submit a report with the task force's recommendations to
- 5 the governor and the legislature not later than 180 days after the
- 6 members of the task force are appointed.
- 7 (5) The task force shall consult with the state board of
- 8 education and any other state agency or department necessary to
- 9 accomplish the task force's responsibilities under this section.
- 10 (6) The members of the task force shall serve without
- 11 compensation but may be reimbursed for actual and necessary
- 12 expenses.
- 13 (7) The business that the board may perform shall be conducted
- 14 at a public meeting of the board held in compliance with the open
- 15 meetings act, 1976 PA 267, MCL 15.261 to 15.275.
- 16 (8) A writing prepared, owned, used, in the possession of, or
- 17 retained by the board in the performance of an official function is
- 18 subject to the freedom of information act, 1976 PA 442, MCL 15.231

- 20 Enacting section 1. This act takes effect 90 days after the
- 21 date it is enacted into law.
