A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending sections 17031 and 17531 (MCL 333.17031 and 333.17531), section 17031 as amended by 2002 PA 643, and by adding sections 17032 and 17532; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 17031. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), AND

 SUBJECT TO SECTION 17032, an applicant, in addition to completing

 the requirements for the degree in medicine, shall complete a

 period of postgraduate education to attain proficiency in the

 practice of the profession, as prescribed by the board in rules, as

 a condition for more than limited licensure.
 - (2) The board may grant a full license to practice medicine to an applicant who has completed the requirements for a degree in

- 1 medicine at a medical school THAT IS located outside the United
- 2 States or Canada if the applicant demonstrates to the board all of
- 3 the following:
- 4 (a) That the applicant has engaged in the practice of medicine
- 5 for not less than 10 years after completing the requirements for a
- 6 degree in medicine.
- 7 (b) That the applicant has completed not less than 3 years of
- 8 postgraduate clinical training in an institution that has an
- 9 affiliation with a medical school that is listed in a directory of
- 10 medical schools published by the world health organization WORLD
- 11 HEALTH ORGANIZATION as approved by the board.
- 12 (c) That the applicant has achieved a score determined by the
- 13 board to be a passing score on an initial medical licensure
- 14 examination approved by the board.
- 15 (d) That the applicant has safely and competently practiced
- 16 medicine under a clinical academic limited license granted by the
- 17 board under this article for 1 or more academic institutions
- 18 located in this state for not less than the 2 years immediately
- 19 preceding the date of application for a license under this
- 20 subsection, during which time the applicant functioned not less
- 21 than 800 hours per year in the observation and treatment of
- 22 patients.
- 23 (3) An applicant under subsection (2) shall file with the
- 24 board a written statement from each academic institution upon ON
- 25 which the applicant relies to satisfy subsection (2)(d). The
- 26 statement shall indicate, at a minimum, that the applicant
- 27 functioned for the academic institution in the observation and

- 1 treatment of patients not less than 800 hours per year and that in
- 2 so doing the applicant practiced medicine safely and competently. A
- 3 person AN INDIVIDUAL who in good faith makes a written statement
- 4 that is filed under this subsection is not civilly or criminally
- 5 liable for that statement. There is a rebuttable presumption that a
- 6 person—AN INDIVIDUAL who makes a written statement that is filed
- 7 under this subsection has done so in good faith.
- 8 SEC. 17032. (1) AN EARLY PRIMARY CARE PROGRAM IS CREATED TO

- 19 (B) THE APPLICANT HAS COMPLETED AT LEAST 1 YEAR OF
- 20 POSTGRADUATE EDUCATION.
- 21 (C) THE APPLICANT HAS RECEIVED A PASSING SCORE IN STEP 1, STEP
- 22 2, AND STEP 3 OF THE UNITED STATES MEDICAL LICENSING BOARD
- 23 EXAMINATION.
- 24 (D) THE APPLICANT ENTERS INTO A WRITTEN EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT
- 25 WITH AN EMPLOYER THAT IS A FOR-PROFIT OR NONPROFIT ENTITY THAT
- 26 INCLUDES ALL OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:
- 27 (i) HIS OR HER AGREEMENT TO WORK AS A PHYSICIAN FOR AT LEAST 2

- 1 YEARS, BEGINNING ON THE DATE HE OR SHE ENTERS THE PROGRAM.

- 8 (3) WITHIN 180 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE AMENDATORY
- 9 ACT THAT ADDED THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REVIEW ANY RULES
- 10 PROMULGATED UNDER THIS PART AND BEGIN THE PROCESS OF AMENDING THOSE
- 11 RULES SO THAT THE RULES ARE CONSISTENT WITH THIS SECTION.

- 21 Sec. 17531. An applicant, in IN addition to completing the
- 22 requirements for the degree in osteopathic medicine and surgery AT

- 24 AND SUBJECT TO SECTION 17532, AN APPLICANT shall complete a period
- 25 of postgraduate education to attain proficiency in the practice of

- 1 SEC. 17532. (1) AN EARLY PRIMARY CARE PROGRAM IS CREATED TO

- 15 2, AND STEP 3 OF THE COMPREHENSIVE OSTEOPATHIC MEDICAL LICENSING

- 17 (D) THE APPLICANT ENTERS INTO A WRITTEN EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT
- 18 WITH AN EMPLOYER THAT IS A FOR-PROFIT OR NONPROFIT ENTITY THAT
- 19 INCLUDES ALL OF THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:
- 20 (i) HIS OR HER AGREEMENT TO WORK AS A PHYSICIAN FOR AT LEAST 2
