## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1307F. THE STATE POLICY UNDER SECTION 1307A SHALL INCLUDE

- 4 (A) THE INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL DISTRICT, IN ACCORDANCE WITH

- 6 REGARDING THE USE OF SECLUSION AND RESTRAINT.
- 7 (B) ALL OF THE FOLLOWING SHOULD OCCUR WITH RESPECT TO THE DATA
- 8 COLLECTED UNDER SUBDIVISION (A):
  - (i) THE DATA SHOULD BE ANALYZED BY THE SCHOOL, THE SCHOOL

- 17 AND RESTRAINT, COMPILED BY DISTRICT ON A QUARTERLY BASIS.
