- 1 SEC. 59C. (1) THIS PART SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO LIMIT,
- 2 MODIFY, WAIVE, OR OTHERWISE AFFECT THE PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES
- 3 GUARANTEED UNDER SECTION 11 OF ARTICLE IV OF THE STATE CONSTITUTION
- 4 OF 1963.
- 5 (2) THIS PART DOES NOT CREATE OR IMPLY A PRIVATE CAUSE OF
- 6 ACTION FOR A VIOLATION OF THIS PART.
  - SEC. 59D. (1) A PUBLIC BODY MAY EXEMPT FROM DISCLOSURE AS A
  - PUBLIC RECORD UNDER THIS PART ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
  - (A) RECORDS OR INFORMATION OF A PERSONAL NATURE IF PUBLIC
  - DISCLOSURE OF THE INFORMATION WOULD CONSTITUTE A CLEARLY

- 13 (2) THIS PART DOES NOT AUTHORIZE THE WITHHOLDING OF ANY SALARY
- 14 RECORD OF AN EMPLOYEE OR OFFICIAL OF A PUBLIC BODY.
- 15 (3) THIS PART DOES NOT AUTHORIZE THE WITHHOLDING OF A RECORD
- 16 OTHERWISE REQUIRED BY LAW TO BE MADE AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC.
- 17 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect January

- 19 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
