HOUSE BILL No. 5546

April 13, 2016, Introduced by Rep. Somerville and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1961 PA 236, entitled "Revised judicature act of 1961," by amending section 5801 (MCL 600.5801).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 5801. No A person may NOT bring or maintain any AN action

for the recovery or possession of any lands REAL PROPERTY or make

any AN entry upon any lands ON REAL PROPERTY unless, after the

claim or right to make the entry first accrued ACCRUES to himself

THE PERSON or to someone through whom he—THE PERSON claims, he—THE

PERSON commences the action or makes the entry within WHICHEVER OF

the FOLLOWING periods of time prescribed by this section.LIMITATION

IS APPLICABLE:

(A) (1) When IF the defendant claims title to the land in question REAL PROPERTY by or through some A deed made upon ON the

- 2 PERSONAL REPRESENTATIVE, guardian, CONSERVATOR, or testamentary
- 3 trustee; or by a sheriff or other proper ministerial officer under

- 5 tribunal of competent jurisdiction within IN this state; —or by a
- 6 sheriff upon ON a mortgage foreclosure sale, the period of
- 7 limitation is 5 years.
- 8 (B) (2) When IF the defendant claims title under some A deed
- 9 made by an officer of this state or of the United States who is
- 10 authorized to make deeds upon—ON the sale of lands—REAL PROPERTY
- 11 for taxes assessed and levied within-IN this state, the period of
- 12 limitation is 10 years.
- 13 (C) (3) When IF the defendant claims title through a devise in
- 14 any A will, the period of limitation is 15 years after the probate
- 15 of the will in this state.
- 16 (D) IF THE DEFENDANT ASSERTS A CLAIM TO THE PROPERTY BASED ON
- 17 ADVERSE POSSESSION OR ACQUIESCENCE, THE PERIOD OF LIMITATION IS 30
- 18 YEARS.
- 19 (E) (4) In all other cases under this section, IF SUBDIVISIONS
- 20 (A) TO (D) DO NOT APPLY, the period of limitation is 15 years.
- 21 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 22 after the date it is enacted into law.
