## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 17751A. (1) A PHARMACIST MAY REFUSE TO DISPENSE A
- 2 PRESCRIPTION IF THE PHARMACIST BELIEVES THAT THE PRESCRIPTION WAS
- 3 NOT WRITTEN BY A PRESCRIBER IN GOOD FAITH OR BELIEVES THAT THE
- 4 PRESCRIPTION IS BEING FILLED FOR A PURPOSE THAT IS NOT A LEGITIMATE
- 5 MEDICAL PURPOSE.
  - (2) A PHARMACIST WHO REFUSES TO DISPENSE A PRESCRIPTION AS
  - AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS SECTION IS NOT LIABLE FOR DAMAGES IN A CIVIL
  - ACTION FOR INJURY, DEATH, OR LOSS TO PERSON OR PROPERTY ARISING
- 9 FROM THE PHARMACIST'S REFUSAL TO DISPENSE THE PRESCRIPTION.
  - Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
