## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1310D. (1) THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE
- 2 SCHOOL DISTRICT OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY,
- 3 OR A SUPERINTENDENT, SCHOOL PRINCIPAL, OR OTHER DESIGNEE UNDER
- 4 SECTION 1311(1), SHALL NOT SUSPEND OR EXPEL A PUPIL UNDER ITS
- 5 AUTHORITY UNDER SECTION 1311(1) SOLELY FOR BEING TRUANT OR
- 6 CHRONICALLY ABSENT.
- 7 (2) THE BOARD OF A SCHOOL DISTRICT OR INTERMEDIATE SCHOOL
- 8 DISTRICT OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY, OR A

- 4 (A) THE PUPIL'S AGE.
- 5 (B) THE PUPIL'S DISCIPLINARY HISTORY.
- 6 (C) WHETHER THE PUPIL IS A STUDENT WITH A DISABILITY.
- 7 (D) THE SERIOUSNESS OF THE VIOLATION OR BEHAVIOR COMMITTED BY
- 8 THE PUPIL.
- 9 (E) WHETHER THE VIOLATION OR BEHAVIOR COMMITTED BY THE PUPIL
- 10 THREATENED THE SAFETY OF ANY PUPIL OR STAFF MEMBER.
