

HOUSE BILL No. 5706

May 26, 2016, Introduced by Rep. Inman and referred to the Committee on Appropriations.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled
"Michigan vehicle code,"
by amending section 819 (MCL 257.819), as amended by 2009 PA 137.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 819. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section,
2 revenue from the increases in fees provided in 1987 PA 232 shall be
3 deposited in the transportation economic development fund
4 established in section 2 of 1987 PA 231, MCL 247.902, and shall not
5 be appropriated for any other purpose in any act making
6 appropriations of state funds.

7 (2) For the fiscal year ending September 30, 1989, and each
8 fiscal year thereafter, of the revenue from the increases in fees
9 provided in 1987 PA 232, \$2,500,000.00 shall be deposited in the
10 state treasury and credited to the general fund, except that not
11 more than \$1,000,000.00 shall be credited to the gasoline

1 inspection and testing fund established in section 8 of the motor
2 fuels quality act, 1984 PA 44, MCL 290.648.

3 (3) Except as provided ~~under~~**IN** subsection (2), for the fiscal
4 year ending September 30, 2008, of the revenue from the increases
5 in fees provided ~~by~~**IN** 1987 PA 232, \$13,000,000.00 shall be
6 deposited in the state treasury and credited to the general fund.

7 (4) Except as provided ~~under~~**IN** subsection (2), for the fiscal
8 year ending September 30, 2009, of prior and current revenues from
9 the increases in fees provided ~~by~~**IN** 1987 PA 232, \$18,000,000.00
10 shall be deposited in the state treasury and credited to the
11 general fund and for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2010,
12 \$12,000,000.00 shall be deposited in the state treasury and
13 credited to the general fund.

14 (5) **EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2), FOR THE FISCAL YEAR**
15 **ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2017, OF THE REVENUE FROM THE INCREASES IN**
16 **FEES PROVIDED IN 1987 PA 232, \$9,423,700.00 SHALL BE DEPOSITED IN**
17 **THE STATE TREASURY AND CREDITED TO THE GENERAL FUND.**

18 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
19 after the date it is enacted into law.
