HOUSE BILL No. 5709

May 31, 2016, Introduced by Reps. Yanez, LaGrand, Cochran, Sarah Roberts, Liberati, Gay-Dagnogo, Wittenberg, Pagan, Darany and Chang and referred to the Committee on Elections.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law,"

by amending sections 697 and 699 (MCL 168.697 and 168.699), section 699 as amended by 2012 PA 523, and by adding section 696a; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 696A. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY LAW TO THE CONTRARY, IF ANY
- 2 PROPOSALS QUALIFY TO BE PLACED ON THE BALLOT, THE PROPOSALS SHALL
- 3 BE PLACED AT THE TOP OF THE BALLOT IN SUBSTANTIALLY THE FOLLOWING 4 ORDER:
 - (A) LOCAL PROPOSALS.
 - (B) COUNTYWIDE PROPOSALS.
 - (C) STATEWIDE PROPOSALS.

- 9 several PARTISAN offices to be voted for SHALL BE PLACED ON THE

- 1 BALLOT FOLLOWING THE NAMES OF THE SEVERAL NONPARTISAN OFFICES
- 2 LISTED IN SECTION 699 AND shall be placed on the ballot
- 3 substantially in the following order in the years in which
- 4 elections for such THOSE offices are held: Electors of president
- 5 and vice-president of the United States; governor and lieutenant
- 6 governor; secretary of state; attorney general; United States
- 7 senator; representative in congress; senator and representative in

- 9 regents of the university of Michigan; trustees of Michigan state

- 26 BALLOT UNDER SECTION 696A AND shall be placed on a separate portion
- 27 of the ballot containing no party designation in the following

- 1 order IN THE YEARS IN WHICH ELECTIONS FOR THOSE OFFICES ARE HELD:
- 2 justices of the supreme court, judges of the court of appeals,
- 3 judges of the circuit court, judges of the probate court, judges of

- 6 following village officers in substantially the following order in
- 7 the year in which elections for the offices are held: president,
- 8 clerk, treasurer, and trustees, and in a year in which an election
