- 3 (2) THE BOARD MAY, IN ADDITION TO CASINOS, PROVIDE FOR SPORTS
- 4 BETTING AGENTS TO ACCEPT WAGERS ON SPORTING EVENTS TO FACILITATE

- 6 (3) THE BOARD SHALL PROMULGATE RULES TO REGULATE SPORTS
