## **HOUSE BILL No. 5907**

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled

"Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 311 (MCL 257.311), as amended by 1983 PA 63; and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 311. (1) The A licensee shall have his or her operator's
- 2 or chauffeur's license, or the receipt described in section 311a,
- 3 in his or her immediate possession at all times when operating a
- 4 motor vehicle, and shall display the same HIS OR HER OPERATOR'S OR
- 5 CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE, OR THE RECEIPT DESCRIBED IN SECTION 311A, upon
- 6 demand of any police officer , who shall identify IDENTIFIES
- 7 himself or herself as such.A POLICE OFFICER.

- 1 (2) IF AN INDIVIDUAL HAS RECEIVED A CITATION FOR A VIOLATION
- 2 OF SUBSECTION (1), THE COURT SHALL WAIVE ANY FINE, COSTS, OR
- 3 ASSESSMENT UPON RECEIPT OF A CERTIFICATION BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT
- 4 AGENCY THAT THE INDIVIDUAL, BEFORE THE APPEARANCE DATE ON THE
- 5 CITATION, HAS PRODUCED HIS OR HER OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE
- 6 AND THAT THE LICENSE WAS VALID ON THE DATE THE VIOLATION OF

- 8 Enacting section 1. Section 901a of the Michigan vehicle code,
- 9 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.901a, is repealed.
- 10 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 11 after the date it is enacted into law.
