

HOUSE BILL No. 5907

September 21, 2016, Introduced by Rep. Chatfield and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled
"Michigan vehicle code,"
by amending section 311 (MCL 257.311), as amended by 1983 PA 63;
and to repeal acts and parts of acts.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 311. **(1)** ~~The~~ **A** licensee shall have his or her operator's
2 or chauffeur's license, or the receipt described in section 311a,
3 in his or her immediate possession at all times when operating a
4 motor vehicle, and shall display ~~the same~~ **HIS OR HER OPERATOR'S OR**
5 **CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE, OR THE RECEIPT DESCRIBED IN SECTION 311A,** upon
6 demand of any police officer ~~who shall identify~~ **IDENTIFIES**
7 himself or herself as ~~such~~ **A POLICE OFFICER.**

1 (2) IF AN INDIVIDUAL HAS RECEIVED A CITATION FOR A VIOLATION
2 OF SUBSECTION (1), THE COURT SHALL WAIVE ANY FINE, COSTS, OR
3 ASSESSMENT UPON RECEIPT OF A CERTIFICATION BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT
4 AGENCY THAT THE INDIVIDUAL, BEFORE THE APPEARANCE DATE ON THE
5 CITATION, HAS PRODUCED HIS OR HER OPERATOR'S OR CHAUFFEUR'S LICENSE
6 AND THAT THE LICENSE WAS VALID ON THE DATE THE VIOLATION OF
7 SUBSECTION (1) OCCURRED.

8 Enacting section 1. Section 901a of the Michigan vehicle code,
9 1949 PA 300, MCL 257.901a, is repealed.

10 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
11 after the date it is enacted into law.
