

# HOUSE BILL No. 5931

September 22, 2016, Introduced by Reps. Singh, Schor, Pscholka, Lane, Lucido, Chirkun, Sheppard and Howell and referred to the Committee on Criminal Justice.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 175, entitled  
"The code of criminal procedure,"  
by amending section 16x of chapter XVII (MCL 777.16x), as amended  
by 2012 PA 323.

### 1 CHAPTER XVII
