A bill to amend 2013 PA 240, entitled "Michigan state capitol historic site act," by amending section 6 (MCL 4.1946).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 6. (1) The commission shall do all of the following:
- 2 (a) Subject to subsection (2), operate and manage the Michigan
- 3 state capitol historic site. STATE CAPITOL HISTORIC SITE.
- 4 (b) Maintain, and REPAIR, restore, RENOVATE, AND IMPROVE the
- 5 state capitol building.STATE CAPITOL BUILDING AND ANY OTHER
- 6 FACILITIES WITHIN THE MICHIGAN STATE CAPITOL HISTORIC SITE.
- 7 (c) Maintain, REPAIR, RESTORE, RENOVATE, and improve the
- 8 grounds of the Michigan state capitol historic site. STATE CAPITOL

- 10 (D) AT ITS DISCRETION, ACQUIRE AND CONSTRUCT ANY NEW FACILITY

- 24 building STATE CAPITOL BUILDING parking lot, including legislative
- 25 or staff offices. All decisions concerning space in the state

- 18 (4) IN CONNECTION WITH THE FINANCING OF ANY NEW FACILITY
- 19 WITHIN THE MICHIGAN STATE CAPITOL HISTORIC SITE UNDER SUBSECTION
- 20 (3), THE COMMISSION MAY AGREE TO THE FINANCING BY THE MICHIGAN
- 21 STRATEGIC FUND OF ANY OTHER IMPROVEMENTS RELATED TO THE STATE
- 22 CAPITOL BUILDING, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, MECHANICAL,
- 23 ELECTRICAL, FIRE SUPPRESSION, SEWER, AND PLUMBING SYSTEMS. THE COST
- 24 OF THESE IMPROVEMENTS MAY BE INCLUDED AS PART OF THE FINANCING
- 25 UNDERTAKEN BY THE MICHIGAN STRATEGIC FUND FOR ANY NEW FACILITY
- 26 WITHIN THE MICHIGAN STATE CAPITOL HISTORIC SITE AND SHALL BE REPAID
- 27 BY LEASE PAYMENTS. THE MICHIGAN STRATEGIC FUND MAY ISSUE BONDS FOR
