HOUSE BILL No. 6082

November 30, 2016, Introduced by Reps. Pscholka and Poleski and referred to the Committee on Local Government.

A bill to amend 1927 PA 339, entitled

"An act to authorize the establishment of a system of retiring allowances for employes of public libraries now existing or which may hereafter be established in incorporated cities of 250,000 population or more,"

by amending section 2 (MCL 38.702).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 2. (1) It shall be the duty of said A library board when
- 2 it DESCRIBED IN SECTION 1 THAT desires to establish a RETIREMENT
- 3 system of retiring allowances, to SHALL apply to the local

- 6 RETIREMENT SYSTEM ESTABLISHED UNDER THIS ACT IS SUBJECT TO THE
- 7 LOCAL UNIT OF GOVERNMENT RETIREMENT ACT.
- 8 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act does not take effect
