## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 933. A person who makes a false affidavit or swears
- 2 falsely while under oath under section 848 or for the purpose of
- 3 securing registration, for the purpose of voting at an election, or
- 4 for the purpose of qualifying as a candidate for elective office
- 5 under section 558 is guilty of perjury. IN ADDITION, A PERSON WHO
- 6 AIDS OR ASSISTS A PERSON WHO MAKES A FALSE AFFIDAVIT OR SWEARS
- 7 FALSELY WHILE UNDER OATH UNDER SECTION 848 OR FOR THE PURPOSE OF
- 8 SECURING REGISTRATION, FOR THE PURPOSE OF VOTING AT AN ELECTION, OR
- 9 FOR THE PURPOSE OF QUALIFYING AS A CANDIDATE FOR ELECTIVE OFFICE

- 1 UNDER SECTION 558 IS GUILTY OF PERJURY.
- 2 Sec. 936. Any person found guilty of perjury under the
- 3 provisions of this act shall, unless herein otherwise provided, be
- 4 punished by a fine not exceeding \$1,000.00, or by imprisonment in
- 5 the state prison for a term not exceeding 5 years, or by both such
- 6 fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the court. EXCEPT AS
