

# HOUSE BILL No. 6104

December 6, 2016, Introduced by Reps. Liberati, Kosowski, Vaupel, Howrylak, Lucido and Santana and referred to the Committee on Criminal Justice.

A bill to amend 1975 PA 238, entitled  
"Child protection law,"  
(MCL 722.621 to 722.638) by adding section 14a.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1        SEC. 14A. IF THE DEPARTMENT RECEIVES INFORMATION THAT A CHILD  
2 OR A PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CHILD'S HEALTH OR WELFARE HAS BEEN  
3 THE VICTIM OF AN ASSAULTIVE CRIME, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE THE  
4 CHILD AND THE PERSON RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CHILD'S HEALTH OR WELFARE  
5 INFORMATION ORALLY AND IN WRITING REGARDING THE LOCATION OF AND  
6 SERVICES OFFERED BY CRIME SURVIVOR TRAUMA RECOVERY CENTERS  
7 ESTABLISHED UNDER THE CRIME SURVIVOR TRAUMA RECOVERY CENTER ACT. AS  
8 USED IN THIS SECTION, "ASSAULTIVE CRIME" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED  
9 IN SECTION 9A OF CHAPTER X OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1927  
10 PA 175, MCL 770.9A.

11        Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days

1 after the date it is enacted into law.

2 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect  
3 unless Senate Bill No. \_\_\_\_\_ or House Bill No. 6106(request no.  
4 06531'16) of the 98th Legislature is enacted into law.
