

HOUSE BILL No. 6105

December 6, 2016, Introduced by Reps. Kesto, Kosowski, Vaupel, Howrylak, Lucido, Santana and Liberati and referred to the Committee on Criminal Justice.

A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled
"The social welfare act,"
(MCL 400.1 to 400.119b) by adding section 10h.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 10H. (1) IF THE DEPARTMENT RECEIVES INFORMATION THAT A
2 RECIPIENT HAS BEEN THE VICTIM OF AN ASSAULTIVE CRIME, THE
3 DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE THE RECIPIENT INFORMATION ORALLY AND IN
4 WRITING REGARDING THE LOCATION OF AND SERVICES OFFERED BY CRIME
5 SURVIVOR TRAUMA RECOVERY CENTERS ESTABLISHED UNDER THE CRIME
6 SURVIVOR TRAUMA RECOVERY CENTER ACT.

7 (2) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:

8 (A) "ASSAULTIVE CRIME" MEANS THAT TERM AS DEFINED IN SECTION
9 9A OF CHAPTER X OF THE CODE OF CRIMINAL PROCEDURE, 1927 PA 175, MCL
10 770.9A.

11 (B) "RECIPIENT" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL RECEIVING PUBLIC

1 ASSISTANCE.

2 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
3 after the date it is enacted into law.

4 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
5 unless Senate Bill No. ____ or House Bill No. 6106 (request no.
6 06531'16) of the 98th Legislature is enacted into law.
