January 27, 2015, Introduced by Senator HOOD and referred to the Committee on Judiciary.

A bill to amend 1931 PA 328, entitled "The Michigan penal code,"

(MCL 750.1 to 750.568) by adding section 81f.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 81F. (1) A PERSON WHO ASSAULTS, BATTERS, OR ASSAULTS AND
- 2 BATTERS, OR WHO SOLICITS OR ENCOURAGES ANOTHER PERSON TO ASSAULT,
- 3 BATTER, OR ASSAULT AND BATTER, AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS PERFORMING HIS
- 4 OR HER DUTIES AS A SPORTS OFFICIAL WHILE AT A SPORTING EVENT OR
- 5 THROUGH SOCIAL MEDIA IS GUILTY OF A FELONY PUNISHABLE BY
- 6 IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 3 YEARS OR A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN
- 7 \$10,000.00, OR BOTH.
- 8 (2) THIS SECTION DOES NOT PROHIBIT A PERSON FROM BEING CHARGED
- 9 WITH, CONVICTED OF, OR PUNISHED FOR ANY OTHER VIOLATION OF LAW
- ARISING OUT OF THE SAME TRANSACTION AS THE VIOLATION OF THIS

- 3 (A) "SPORTING EVENT" MEANS ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 4 (i) AN ORGANIZED COMPETITIVE ATHLETIC ACTIVITY BETWEEN 2 OR

- 6 (ii) AN EVENT THAT IS CONDUCTED BEFORE OR AFTER AN ATHLETIC

- 10 (B) "SPORTS OFFICIAL" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO DOES EITHER OF

- 12 (i) OFFICIALLY ADMINISTERS OR OFFICIALLY ASSISTS IN
- 13 ADMINISTERING THE RULES AT ANY SPORTING EVENT, INCLUDING, BUT NOT
- 14 LIMITED TO, A REFEREE.
- 15 (ii) COACHES OR ASSISTS IN COACHING INDIVIDUALS INVOLVED IN ANY
- 16 SPORTING EVENT.
- 17 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 18 after the date it is enacted into law.
