

SENATE BILL No. 186

March 5, 2015, Introduced by Senators STAMAS, PROOS, KNEZEK, SCHMIDT, BRANDENBURG, HOPGOOD, GREEN, CASPERSON, BOOHER and JONES and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code," (MCL 257.1 to 257.923) by adding sections 811cc, 811dd, 811ee, 811ff, and 811gg.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 SEC. 811CC. (1) A FUND-RAISING PLATE OR COLLECTOR PLATE
2 RECOGNIZING THE DETROIT RED WINGS SHALL BEAR AN APPROPRIATE LOGO,
3 THE DESIGN OF WHICH THE DETROIT RED WINGS SHALL SUBMIT TO THE
4 SECRETARY OF STATE. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL CONFER WITH THE
5 DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE TO ENSURE THAT THE DESIGN WILL NOT
6 COMPROMISE THE ABILITY OF LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES TO ACCURATELY
7 IDENTIFY SPECIFIC VEHICLES.

8 (2) REGISTRATION PLATES BEARING A DETROIT RED WINGS LOGO SHALL
9 NOT BE A DUPLICATION OF ANOTHER REGISTRATION PLATE. THE DETROIT RED

1 WINGS SHALL COMPLY WITH SECTION 803M(3)(C) AND (D) AND (4)(C) AND
2 (D).

3 (3) THE DETROIT RED WINGS FUND IS CREATED WITHIN THE STATE
4 TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS
5 FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER
6 SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL
7 CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM FUND INVESTMENTS.
8 MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN
9 THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.

10 (4) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL TRANSFER THE DONATION MONEY
11 FROM THE SALE OF FUND-RAISING PLATES RECOGNIZING THE DETROIT RED
12 WINGS TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE DONATION MONEY
13 TO THE DETROIT RED WINGS FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (3).

14 (5) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DISBURSE MONEY IN THE FUND
15 ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (3) ON A QUARTERLY BASIS TO THE
16 DETROIT RED WINGS FOUNDATION. BEGINNING NOT LATER THAN 1 YEAR AFTER
17 THE SECRETARY OF STATE ISSUES THE FUND-RAISING PLATE DESCRIBED IN
18 THIS SECTION AND ANNUALLY THEREAFTER, THE DETROIT RED WINGS
19 FOUNDATION SHALL SUBMIT TO THE STATE TREASURER A SUMMARY OF THE
20 EXPENDITURES DURING THE PRECEDING YEAR OF THE MONEY RECEIVED UNDER
21 THIS SECTION.

22 SEC. 811DD. (1) A FUND-RAISING PLATE OR COLLECTOR PLATE
23 RECOGNIZING THE DETROIT TIGERS IN THIS STATE SHALL BEAR AN
24 APPROPRIATE LOGO, THE DESIGN OF WHICH THE DETROIT TIGERS SHALL
25 SUBMIT TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL
26 CONFER WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE TO ENSURE THAT THE
27 DESIGN WILL NOT COMPROMISE THE ABILITY OF LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES

1 TO ACCURATELY IDENTIFY SPECIFIC VEHICLES.

2 (2) REGISTRATION PLATES BEARING A DETROIT TIGERS LOGO SHALL
3 NOT BE A DUPLICATION OF ANOTHER REGISTRATION PLATE. THE DETROIT
4 TIGERS SHALL COMPLY WITH SECTION 803M(3) (C) AND (D) AND (4) (C) AND
5 (D).

6 (3) THE DETROIT TIGERS FUND IS CREATED WITHIN THE STATE
7 TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS
8 FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER
9 SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL
10 CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM FUND INVESTMENTS.
11 MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN
12 THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.

13 (4) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL TRANSFER THE DONATION MONEY
14 FROM THE SALE OF FUND-RAISING PLATES RECOGNIZING THE DETROIT TIGERS
15 TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE DONATION MONEY TO THE

17 (5) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DISBURSE MONEY IN THE FUND
18 ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (3) ON A QUARTERLY BASIS TO THE
19 DETROIT TIGERS FOUNDATION. BEGINNING NOT LATER THAN 1 YEAR AFTER

24 SEC. 811EE. (1) A FUND-RAISING PLATE OR COLLECTOR PLATE
25 RECOGNIZING THE DETROIT LIONS SHALL BEAR AN APPROPRIATE LOGO, THE
26 DESIGN OF WHICH THE DETROIT LIONS SHALL SUBMIT TO THE SECRETARY OF
27 STATE. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL CONFER WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF

1 STATE POLICE TO ENSURE THAT THE DESIGN WILL NOT COMPROMISE THE
2 ABILITY OF LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES TO ACCURATELY IDENTIFY SPECIFIC
3 VEHICLES.

4 (2) REGISTRATION PLATES BEARING A DETROIT LIONS LOGO SHALL NOT
5 BE A DUPLICATION OF ANOTHER REGISTRATION PLATE. THE DETROIT LIONS
6 SHALL COMPLY WITH SECTION 803M(3) (C) AND (D) AND (4) (C) AND (D).

7 (3) THE DETROIT LIONS FUND IS CREATED WITHIN THE STATE
8 TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS
9 FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER
10 SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL
11 CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM FUND INVESTMENTS.
12 MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN

21 SECRETARY OF STATE ISSUES THE FUND-RAISING PLATE DESCRIBED IN THIS
22 SECTION AND ANNUALLY THEREAFTER, THE DETROIT LIONS CHARITIES SHALL
23 SUBMIT TO THE STATE TREASURER A SUMMARY OF THE EXPENDITURES DURING
24 THE PRECEDING YEAR OF THE MONEY RECEIVED UNDER THIS SECTION.

25 SEC. 811FF. (1) A FUND-RAISING PLATE OR COLLECTOR PLATE
26 RECOGNIZING THE DETROIT PISTONS IN THIS STATE SHALL BEAR AN
27 APPROPRIATE LOGO, THE DESIGN OF WHICH THE DETROIT PISTONS SHALL

1 SUBMIT TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL
2 CONFER WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE TO ENSURE THAT THE
3 DESIGN WILL NOT COMPROMISE THE ABILITY OF LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES
4 TO ACCURATELY IDENTIFY SPECIFIC VEHICLES.

5 (2) REGISTRATION PLATES BEARING A DETROIT PISTONS LOGO SHALL
6 NOT BE A DUPLICATION OF ANOTHER REGISTRATION PLATE. THE DETROIT
7 PISTONS SHALL COMPLY WITH SECTION 803M(3)(C) AND (D) AND (4)(C) AND
8 (D).

9 (3) THE DETROIT PISTONS FUND IS CREATED WITHIN THE STATE
10 TREASURY. THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS
11 FROM ANY SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER
12 SHALL DIRECT THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL
13 CREDIT TO THE FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM FUND INVESTMENTS.
14 MONEY IN THE FUND AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN
15 THE FUND AND SHALL NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.

16 (4) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL TRANSFER THE DONATION MONEY
17 FROM THE SALE OF FUND-RAISING PLATES RECOGNIZING THE DETROIT
18 PISTONS TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE DONATION MONEY
19 TO THE DETROIT PISTONS FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (3).

20 (5) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DISBURSE MONEY IN THE FUND
21 ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (3) ON A QUARTERLY BASIS TO THE COME
22 TOGETHER FOUNDATION. BEGINNING NOT LATER THAN 1 YEAR AFTER THE
23 SECRETARY OF STATE ISSUES THE FUND-RAISING PLATE DESCRIBED IN THIS
24 SECTION AND ANNUALLY THEREAFTER, THE COME TOGETHER FOUNDATION SHALL
25 SUBMIT TO THE STATE TREASURER A SUMMARY OF THE EXPENDITURES DURING
26 THE PRECEDING YEAR OF THE MONEY RECEIVED UNDER THIS SECTION.

27 SEC. 811GG. (1) A FUND-RAISING PLATE OR COLLECTOR PLATE

1 RECOGNIZING MICHIGAN INTERNATIONAL SPEEDWAY SHALL BEAR AN
2 APPROPRIATE LOGO, THE DESIGN OF WHICH A REPRESENTATIVE OR AGENT OF
3 MICHIGAN INTERNATIONAL SPEEDWAY SHALL SUBMIT TO THE SECRETARY OF
4 STATE. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL CONFER WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF
5 STATE POLICE TO ENSURE THAT THE DESIGN WILL NOT COMPROMISE THE
6 ABILITY OF LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES TO ACCURATELY IDENTIFY SPECIFIC
7 VEHICLES.

8 (2) REGISTRATION PLATES BEARING A MICHIGAN INTERNATIONAL
9 SPEEDWAY LOGO SHALL NOT BE A DUPLICATION OF ANOTHER REGISTRATION
10 PLATE. MICHIGAN INTERNATIONAL SPEEDWAY SHALL COMPLY WITH SECTION
11 803M(3)(C) AND (D) AND (4)(C) AND (D).

12 (3) THE MIS CARES FUND IS CREATED WITHIN THE STATE TREASURY.
13 THE STATE TREASURER MAY RECEIVE MONEY OR OTHER ASSETS FROM ANY
14 SOURCE FOR DEPOSIT INTO THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DIRECT
15 THE INVESTMENT OF THE FUND. THE STATE TREASURER SHALL CREDIT TO THE
16 FUND INTEREST AND EARNINGS FROM FUND INVESTMENTS. MONEY IN THE FUND
17 AT THE CLOSE OF THE FISCAL YEAR SHALL REMAIN IN THE FUND AND SHALL
18 NOT LAPSE TO THE GENERAL FUND.

19 (4) THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL TRANSFER THE DONATION MONEY
20 FROM THE SALE OF FUND-RAISING PLATES RECOGNIZING MICHIGAN
21 INTERNATIONAL SPEEDWAY TO THE STATE TREASURER, WHO SHALL CREDIT THE
22 DONATION MONEY TO THE MIS CARES FUND ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION
23 (3).

24 (5) THE STATE TREASURER SHALL DISBURSE MONEY IN THE FUND
25 ESTABLISHED UNDER SUBSECTION (3) ON A QUARTERLY BASIS TO MIS CARES.
26 BEGINNING NOT LATER THAN 1 YEAR AFTER THE SECRETARY OF STATE ISSUES
27 THE FUND-RAISING PLATE DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION AND ANNUALLY

1 THEREAFTER, MIS CARES SHALL SUBMIT TO THE STATE TREASURER A SUMMARY
2 OF THE EXPENDITURES DURING THE PRECEDING YEAR OF THE MONEY RECEIVED
3 UNDER THIS SECTION.

4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
5 after the date it is enacted into law.
