A bill to amend 1978 PA 472, entitled

"An act to regulate political activity; to regulate lobbyists, lobbyist agents, and lobbying activities; to require registration of lobbyists and lobbyist agents; to require the filing of reports; to prescribe the powers and duties of the department of state; to prescribe penalties; and to repeal certain acts and parts of acts,"

by amending section 6a (MCL 4.416a), as added by 1994 PA 383.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 6a. (1) A FORMER MEMBER OF THE MICHIGAN SENATE OR HOUSE
- 2 OF REPRESENTATIVES OR A FORMER GOVERNOR, LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR,
- 3 ATTORNEY GENERAL, OR SECRETARY OF STATE OF THIS STATE SHALL NOT
- 4 MAKE EXPENDITURES FOR OR RECEIVE COMPENSATION FOR LOBBYING THAT IS
- 5 EQUAL TO OR EXCEEDS THE MONETARY THRESHOLD REQUIRED FOR REGISTERING
- 6 AS A LOBBYIST AGENT FOR 2 YEARS IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE END OF
- 7 THE TERM OF OFFICE TO WHICH HE OR SHE WAS ELECTED.
