- 3 BEEN INDIVIDUALLY TRAINED TO DO WORK OR PERFORM TASKS FOR THE
- 4 BENEFIT OF A PERSON WITH A DISABILITY, INCLUDING A PHYSICAL,
- 5 SENSORY, PSYCHIATRIC, INTELLECTUAL, OR OTHER MENTAL DISABILITY.
