## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

certified abandoned property, on **OR WITHIN 60 DAYS BEFORE** the June 1 immediately succeeding the date that unpaid taxes are returned to the county treasurer for forfeiture, foreclosure, and sale under section 60a(1) or (2) or returned to the county treasurer as delinquent under section 78a, the county treasurer shall send notice of all the following by first-class mail, address correction requested, to the person to whom a tax bill for property returned for delinquent taxes was last sent or to the person identified as
