

SENATE BILL No. 432

July 1, 2015, Introduced by Senator CASPERSON and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1945 PA 327, entitled
"Aeronautics code of the state of Michigan,"
(MCL 259.1 to 259.208) by adding section 96.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 **SEC. 96. (1) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS OPERATING A DRONE SHALL NOT**
2 **FLY THE DRONE TO WITHIN 1,000 FEET OF THE MACKINAC BRIDGE.**

3 **(2) SUBSECTION (1) DOES NOT APPLY TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS AN**
4 **EMPLOYEE OR AGENT OF THE MACKINAC BRIDGE AUTHORITY WHO IS ACTING**
5 **WITHIN THE SCOPE OF HIS OR HER EMPLOYMENT OR AGENCY AND FLYING THE**
6 **DRONE FOR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES:**

7 **(A) AN ENGINEERING INSPECTION.**

8 **(B) SECURITY.**

9 **(C) MARKETING.**

10 **(3) AN INDIVIDUAL WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A**
11 **MISDEMEANOR PUNISHABLE BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 93 DAYS OR**

1 **A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.00, OR BOTH.**

2 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
3 after the date it is enacted into law.

4 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect
5 unless Senate Bill No. 433

6 of the 98th Legislature is enacted into law.
