(a) The secretary of state determines that the standards of 1 2 the other country for licensing operators correspond substantially to those of this state and that the other country extends the same 3 4 privileges to persons licensed to operate vehicles by this state. (b) The secretary of state and the other country have 5 exchanged letters confirming the reciprocal extension of privileges 6 7 to operate vehicles. (2) The secretary of state shall publish on its public 8 internet site a list of the countries for which reciprocal 9 operating privileges have been extended and withdrawn. If any 10 11 changes are made, a revised list shall be mailed to the courts, 12 prosecuting attorneys, and law enforcement agencies of this state. Enacting section 1.
