

SENATE BILL No. 502

September 17, 2015, Introduced by Senators MARLEAU, SHIRKEY, JONES, STAMAS and ROBERTSON and referred to the Committee on Health Policy.

A bill to amend 1984 PA 323, entitled
"The health care false claim act,"
by amending section 4a (MCL 752.1004a), as added by 2004 PA 411.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

1 Sec. 4a. (1) A rebate, ~~or~~ discount, **OR SIMILAR PAYMENT** from a
2 drug manufacturer or from a company that licenses or distributes
3 the drugs of a drug manufacturer to a consumer **OR OTHER PERSON ON**
4 **THE CONSUMER'S BEHALF**, for that consumer's use of a drug
5 manufactured or licensed or distributed by that drug manufacturer
6 or company **OR FOR HEALTH CARE ITEMS OR SERVICES RELATED TO THAT**
7 **USE**, does not violate section 4.

8 (2) This section does not alter any copayment, deductible,
9 coinsurance, or other cost-sharing requirements under a contract,
10 certificate, or policy issued by a health care corporation or

1 health care insurer.

2 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
3 after the date it is enacted into law.
