SENATE BILL No. 555

October 8, 2015, Introduced by Senators SCHUITMAKER and HORN and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1980 PA 299, entitled "Occupational code," by amending section 210 (MCL 339.210).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 210. (1) The department, on its own behalf and on behalf of a board created under this act, may contract with persons or agencies who are not employees or agencies of the department to implement this act and to fulfill the responsibilities of the department or a board.

(2) UNDER SUBSECTION (1), THE DEPARTMENT MAY ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH AN ENTITY THAT IS NOT AN AGENCY OF A STATE OR THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT TO PROVIDE AN ELECTRONIC CONTINUING EDUCATION TRACKING SYSTEM THAT PROVIDES AN ELECTRONIC RECORD OF THE CONTINUING EDUCATION COURSES, CLASSES, OR PROGRAMS COMPLETED BY ALL

- 11 REGISTRANTS CONDUCTED BY THE DEPARTMENT.
- 12 (C) THE SYSTEM MUST PROVIDE ACCESS TO CONTINUING EDUCATION
- 13 INFORMATION ABOUT AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS LICENSED OR REGISTERED UNDER
- 14 THIS ACT TO THE INDIVIDUAL, TO THE APPROPRIATE BOARD FOR THE
- 15 INDIVIDUAL'S OCCUPATION, AND TO THE DEPARTMENT.
- 16 (3) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROMULGATE ANY RULES IT CONSIDERS
- 17 APPROPRIATE TO IMPLEMENT AND ADMINISTER SUBSECTION (2).
- 18 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 19 after the date it is enacted into law.
