SENATE BILL No. 568

October 15, 2015, Introduced by Senators ZORN, JONES, HORN, HANSEN and BOOHER and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 803e (MCL 257.803e), as amended by 2011 PA 46.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 803e. (1) A person who has been a prisoner of war or a person whose spouse has been a prisoner of war may make application to the secretary of state for a special registration plate that shall be—inscribed with special identification numbers preceded by the letters "EX-POW" and shall have—the words "ex-prisoner of war" inscribed beneath the registration number.
 - (2) A person who was a member of the armed services during World War I may make application to the secretary of state for a special registration plate , that shall be inscribed with special identification numbers preceded by the letters "WWI" and shall have

- 1 the words "World War I veteran" inscribed beneath the registration
- 2 number.
- 3 (3) A person who was a member of the armed services during
- 4 1941, stationed at a United States military or naval establishment
- 5 at Pearl Harbor in the Hawaiian islands, and who survived the
- 6 attack by Japan on Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941 may make
- 7 application to the secretary of state for a special registration
- 8 plate , that shall be inscribed with special identification numbers
- 9 and shall have the words "Pearl Harbor survivor" inscribed beneath
- 10 the registration number.
- 11 (4) A person who is a recipient of the purple heart medal may
- 12 make application to the secretary of state for a special
- 13 registration plate that shall be inscribed with special
- 14 identification numbers and shall have the words "combat wounded
- 15 veteran" inscribed beneath the registration number. In addition,
- 16 the special registration plate described under IN this subsection
- 17 shall be inscribed with a vignette of the official purple heart
- 18 medal.
- 19 (5) Application for a special registration plate shall be on a
- 20 form prescribed by the secretary of state —and shall be
- 21 accompanied by any proof of the applicant having been a prisoner of
- 22 war, World War I veteran, Pearl Harbor survivor, OR recipient of
- 23 the purple heart medal that the secretary of state may require.
- 24 Application for a "Gold Star Family" special registration plate
- 25 described in subsection (9) shall be on a form prescribed by the
- 26 secretary of state and shall be accompanied by any proof of the
- 27 applicant having been a gold star family member that the secretary

- 2 plate shall also be accompanied with payment of a \$5.00 service
- 3 fee.
- 4 (6) Upon proper application and payment of the \$5.00 service
- 5 fee, the secretary of state shall issue 1 or more special
- 6 registration plates for each applicant for use on a passenger
- 7 vehicle OR, FOR PURPOSES OF SUBSECTION (1), FOR USE ON A
- 8 MOTORCYCLE. A person who is disabled who makes application for a
- 9 special registration plate under this section and who makes payment
- 10 of the \$5.00 service fee shall be issued a tab for persons with
- 11 disabilities as provided in section 803f for his or her special
- 12 registration plate. The secretary of state shall require the same
- 13 proof that the applicant is a disabled person as is required for
- 14 issuance of a permanent windshield placard under section 675. One
- 15 person in any household is entitled to 1 special registration plate
- 16 issued under subsection (1) that is exempt from payment of the tax
- 17 provided in section 801. The person who is issued an additional
- 18 special registration plate under subsection (1) shall be assessed
- 19 the applicable tax provided for in section 801. A person issued 1
- 20 or more special registration plates under subsection (2), (3), (4),
- 21 or (9) shall be assessed the applicable tax provided in section
- 22 801.
- 23 (7) The use of a special registration plate on a vehicle other
- 24 than the vehicle for which the plate is issued, or by a person who
- 25 does not qualify under this section, is a misdemeanor.
- 26 (8) The special registration plate issued under this section
- 27 expires on the birthday of the vehicle owner in a year in which new

- 2 renewal of the special registration plate shall be accompanied by a
- 3 \$5.00 service fee. The applicant is not required to furnish the
- 4 proof provided in subsection (5).
- 5 (9) A gold star family member may make application to the
- 6 secretary of state for a special registration plate that shall be
- 7 inscribed with special identification numbers preceded by a gold
- 8 star and shall have the words "Gold Star Family" inscribed beneath
- 9 the registration number.
- 10 (10) As used in this section, "gold star family member" means
- 11 a person who has had an immediate family member die while serving
- 12 in the United States armed forces ARMED FORCES or in forces
- 13 incorporated as part of the United States armed forces ARMED FORCES
- 14 if the immediate family member meets any of the eligibility
- 15 criteria specified in 10 USC 1126(a)(1) to (3) for a gold star
- 16 lapel button.
- 17 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 18 after the date it is enacted into law.
