SENATE BILL No. 569

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 3. (1) Each fiscal year following the fiscal year in which a fund is created, the governing body of the municipality which THAT created the fund may appropriate TO THE FUND, by an ordinance or resolution adopted by a 2/3 vote of the members elected and serving, all or part of a surplus in the general fund resulting from an excess of revenue in comparison to expenses. , to the fund.

(2) A municipality shall not impose additional taxes producing revenue in excess of that needed for its estimated budget in order to provide for money to be appropriated to the fund.
