

# SENATE BILL No. 584

October 27, 2015, Introduced by Senators MACGREGOR, HORN, HERTEL and KNOLLENBERG and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1998 PA 58, entitled  
"Michigan liquor control code of 1998,"  
(MCL 436.1101 to 436.2303) by adding section 545a.

**THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:**

1           SEC. 545A. (1) THE COMMISSION, ON SUBMISSION OF A COMPLETED  
2 APPLICATION, SHALL GRANT A HOME FOR THE AGED LICENSE TO AN  
3 APPLICANT COMPLYING WITH THIS SECTION. THE TOTAL NUMBER OF LICENSES  
4 ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY NOT EXCEED 20. IF THE HOLDER OF A  
5 LICENSE ISSUED UNDER THIS SECTION GOES OUT OF BUSINESS, THE LICENSE  
6 MUST BE SURRENDERED TO THE COMMISSION. THE COMMISSION MAY ALLOW THE  
7 TRANSFER OF THE LICENSE TO A NEW BUSINESS OWNER ON TRANSFER OF THE  
8 OWNER'S INTEREST IN THE BUSINESS.

9           (2) THE HOLDER OF A HOME FOR THE AGED LICENSE MAY SELL AT  
10 RETAIL AND SERVE ON THE LICENSED PREMISES BEER, WINE, MIXED SPIRIT

1 DRINK, MIXED WINE DRINK, AND SPIRITS, FOR CONSUMPTION ON THE  
2 LICENSED PREMISES BY A RESIDENT OR A BONA FIDE GUEST ACCOMPANYING  
3 THE RESIDENT.

4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days  
5 after the date it is enacted into law.

6 Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect  
7 unless all of the following bills of the 98th Legislature are  
8 enacted into law:
