SENATE BILL No. 640

December 3, 2015, Introduced by Senator ROBERTSON and referred to the Committee on Elections and Government Reform.

A bill to amend 1954 PA 116, entitled "Michigan election law," by amending section 957 (MCL 168.957).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 957. (1) A person circulating a RECALL petition shall be

a qualified and registered elector in the electoral district of the
official sought to be recalled and shall attach thereto his
certificate stating that he is a qualified and registered elector
in the electoral district of the official sought to be recalled and
shall state the city or the township wherein he resides and his
post-office address; further, that STATE IN THE CERTIFICATE OF
CIRCULATOR HIS OR HER RESIDENCE ADDRESS AND THAT HE OR SHE IS 18
YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER AND A UNITED STATES CITIZEN. IN ADDITION, THE

- 1 CERTIFICATE OF CIRCULATOR SHALL INDICATE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 2 (A) THAT signatures appearing upon the RECALL petition were
- 3 not obtained through fraud, deceit, or misrepresentation and that
- 4 he OR SHE has neither caused nor permitted a person to sign the
- 5 RECALL petition more than once and has no knowledge of a person
- 6 signing the RECALL petition more than once. ; that
- 7 (B) THAT all signatures to the RECALL petition were affixed in
- 8 his OR HER presence. ; and that
- 9 (C) THAT, to the best of his OR HER knowledge, information,
- 10 and belief, the signers of the RECALL petition are qualified and
- 11 registered electors and the signatures appearing thereon ON THE
- 12 RECALL PETITION are the genuine signatures of the persons of whom
- 13 they purport to be. SIGNING THE RECALL PETITION.
- 14 (2) A person who knowingly makes a false statement in the
- 15 certificate hereby required OF CIRCULATOR is guilty of a
- 16 misdemeanor.
- 17 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 18 after the date it is enacted into law.
