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## **SENATE BILL No. 781**

February 11, 2016, Introduced by Senators SCHUITMAKER and O'BRIEN and referred to the Committee on Transportation.

A bill to amend 1949 PA 300, entitled "Michigan vehicle code,"

by amending section 803e (MCL 257.803e), as amended by 2011 PA 46.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 803e. (1) A person who has been a prisoner of war or a person whose spouse has been a prisoner of war may make application to the secretary of state for a special registration plate that shall be inscribed with special identification numbers preceded by the letters "EX-POW" and shall have the words "ex-prisoner of war" inscribed beneath the registration number.

(2) A person who was a member of the armed services during World War I may make application to the secretary of state for a special registration plate , that shall be inscribed with special identification numbers preceded by the letters "WWI" and shall have

- 1 the words "World War I veteran" inscribed beneath the registration
- 2 number.
- 3 (3) A person who was a member of the armed services during
- 4 1941, stationed at a United States military or naval establishment
- 5 at Pearl Harbor in the Hawaiian islands, and who survived the
- 6 attack by Japan on Pearl Harbor on December 7, 1941 may make
- 7 application to the secretary of state for a special registration
- 8 plate , that shall be inscribed with special identification numbers
- 9 and shall have the words "Pearl Harbor survivor" inscribed beneath
- 10 the registration number.
- 11 (4) A person who is a recipient of the purple heart medal may
- 12 make application to the secretary of state for a special
- 13 registration plate that shall be inscribed with special
- 14 identification numbers and shall have the words "combat wounded
- 15 veteran" inscribed beneath the registration number. In addition,
- 16 the special registration plate described under IN this subsection
- 17 shall be inscribed with a vignette of the official purple heart
- 18 medal.
- 19 (5) Application for a special registration plate shall be on a
- 20 form prescribed by the secretary of state —and shall be
- 21 accompanied by any proof of the applicant having been a prisoner of
- 22 war, World War I veteran, Pearl Harbor survivor, OR recipient of
- 23 the purple heart medal that the secretary of state may require.
- 24 Application for a "Gold Star Family" special registration plate
- 25 described in subsection (9) shall be on a form prescribed by the
- 26 secretary of state and shall be accompanied by any proof of the
- 27 applicant having been a gold star family member that the secretary

- 1 of state may require. APPLICATION FOR AN "HONOR AND REMEMBER"
- 2 SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE SHALL BE ON A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE
- 3 SECRETARY OF STATE. THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL NOT IMPOSE ANY
- 4 ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS UPON AN APPLICANT FOR AN "HONOR AND
- 5 REMEMBER" PLATE. The application for a special registration plate
- 6 UNDER SUBSECTIONS (1) TO (4) AND SUBSECTION (9) shall also be
- 7 accompanied with payment of a \$5.00 service fee. THE SECRETARY OF
- 8 STATE SHALL NOT REQUIRE PAYMENT OF A \$5.00 SERVICE FEE FOR AN
- 9 "HONOR AND REMEMBER" SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE.
- 10 (6) Upon proper application and payment of the \$5.00 service
- 11 fee, IF APPLICABLE, the secretary of state shall issue 1 or more
- 12 special registration plates for each applicant for use on a
- 13 passenger vehicle. A person who is disabled who makes application
- 14 for a special registration plate under this section and who makes
- 15 payment of the \$5.00 service fee, IF APPLICABLE, shall be issued a
- 16 tab for persons with disabilities as provided in section 803f for
- 17 his or her special registration plate. The secretary of state shall
- 18 require the same proof that the applicant is a disabled person as
- 19 is required for issuance of a permanent windshield placard under
- 20 section 675. One person in any household is entitled to 1 special
- 21 registration plate issued under subsection (1) that is exempt from
- 22 payment of the tax provided in section 801. The person who is
- 23 issued an additional special registration plate under subsection
- 24 (1) shall be assessed the applicable tax provided for in section
- 25 801. A person issued 1 or more special registration plates under
- 26 subsection (2), (3), (4), or (9), OR (10) shall be assessed the
- 27 applicable tax provided in section 801.

- 1 (7) The use of a special registration plate on a vehicle other
- 2 than the vehicle for which the plate is issued, or by a person who
- 3 does not qualify under this section, is a misdemeanor.
- 4 (8) The special registration plate issued under this section
- 5 expires on the birthday of the vehicle owner in a year in which new
- 6 plates are issued by the secretary of state. Application for
- 7 renewal of the special registration plate shall be accompanied by a
- 8 \$5.00 service fee. The applicant is not required to furnish the
- 9 proof provided in subsection (5).
- 10 (9) A gold star family member may make application to the
- 11 secretary of state for a special registration plate that shall be
- 12 inscribed with special identification numbers preceded by a gold
- 13 star and shall have the words "Gold Star Family" inscribed beneath
- 14 the registration number.
- 15 (10) A PERSON MAY MAKE APPLICATION TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE
- 16 FOR A SPECIAL REGISTRATION PLATE INSCRIBED WITH SPECIAL
- 17 IDENTIFICATION NUMBERS PRECEDED BY THE HONOR AND REMEMBER FLAG AND
- 18 THE WORDS "HONOR AND REMEMBER" INSCRIBED BENEATH THE REGISTRATION
- 19 NUMBER. AS USED IN THIS SUBSECTION, "HONOR AND REMEMBER FLAG" MEANS
- 20 THE FLAG DEVELOPED BY THE HONOR AND REMEMBER ORGANIZATION.
- 21 (11) <del>(10)</del> As used in this section, "gold star family member"
- 22 means a person who has had an immediate family member die while
- 23 serving in the United States armed forces ARMED FORCES or in forces
- 24 incorporated as part of the United States armed forces ARMED FORCES
- 25 if the immediate family member meets any of the eligibility
- 26 criteria specified in 10 USC 1126(a)(1) to (3) for a gold star
- 27 lapel button.

- 1 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 2 after the date it is enacted into law.
