SENATE BILL No. 826

March 1, 2016, Introduced by Senators COLBECK, JONES, HORN, SCHUITMAKER, SHIRKEY and ZORN and referred to the Committee on Education.

A bill to amend 1976 PA 451, entitled

"The revised school code,"

(MCL 380.1 to 380.1852) by adding sections 1278e and 1278f.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 1278E. (1) BY ENACTING THIS SECTION, THIS STATE
- 2 TERMINATES ALL PLANS, PROGRAMS, ACTIVITIES, EFFORTS, AND
- 3 EXPENDITURES RELATING TO THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE EDUCATIONAL
- 4 INITIATIVE COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS THE COMMON CORE STANDARDS, OR
- 5 ANY DERIVATIVE OR PERMUTATION OF THAT EDUCATIONAL INITIATIVE
- INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, THE MICHIGAN COLLEGE AND CAREER
- 7 READY STANDARDS THAT HAVE BEEN ADOPTED BY THE LEGISLATURE, THE
- 8 STATE BOARD, OR THE DEPARTMENT AND INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO,
- 9 ANY ASSESSMENTS, DATA COLLECTION, AND INSTRUCTIONS BASED ON OR
- 10 INVOLVING THAT EDUCATIONAL INITIATIVE. TO FURTHER PROTECT STATE AND

- 1 LOCAL CONTROL OF PUBLIC EDUCATION, THE STATE BOARD AND THE
- 2 DEPARTMENT ARE PROHIBITED FROM ADOPTING, ALIGNING TO, OR
- 3 IMPLEMENTING ANY OTHER NATIONAL OR MULTISTATE CONSORTIUM STANDARDS
- 4 FROM ANY SOURCE OR REQUIRING THE USE OF ANY ASSESSMENTS ALIGNED
- 5 WITH ANY OTHER NATIONAL OR MULTISTATE CONSORTIUM STANDARDS FROM ANY
- 6 SOURCE, AND, SUBJECT TO SECTION 1278F, THE STATE BOARD AND THE
- 7 DEPARTMENT SHALL DO ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 8 (A) RESPECT AND SUPPORT THE ULTIMATE RIGHT OF A PARENT TO OPT
- 9 HIS OR HER CHILD OUT OF PUBLIC SCHOOL, AND OUT OF ANY PUBLIC SCHOOL
- 10 ACTIVITY, PRACTICE, OR TESTING THAT THE PARENT FINDS UNACCEPTABLE,
- 11 WITH NO NEGATIVE REPERCUSSIONS TO, OR FINANCIAL IMPACT ON, THE
- 12 CHILD, PARENT, OR SCHOOL AND WITH NO INTERFERENCE FROM THIS STATE.
- 13 THIS SUBDIVISION DOES NOT PROHIBIT THIS STATE FROM FUNDING PUBLIC
- 14 EDUCATION ON A PER-PUPIL BASIS.
- 15 (B) WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SECTION,
- 16 ADOPT AND IMPLEMENT STATE ACADEMIC CONTENT STANDARDS FOR EACH OF
- 17 GRADES KINDERGARTEN TO 12 IN ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS, MATHEMATICS,
- 18 SCIENCE, AND SOCIAL STUDIES. THE STATE ACADEMIC CONTENT STANDARDS
- 19 SHALL BE THE SAME AS THE ACADEMIC STANDARDS IN EFFECT IN
- 20 MASSACHUSETTS DURING THE 2008-2009 SCHOOL YEAR, EXCEPT THAT ANY
- 21 REFERENCE IN THOSE STANDARDS TO "MASSACHUSETTS" SHALL BE CHANGED IN
- 22 ALL APPROPRIATE INSTANCES TO A REFERENCE TO "MICHIGAN" AND ANY
- 23 STATE HISTORY OR GOVERNMENT CONTENT STANDARDS SHALL BE CHANGED TO
- 24 REFLECT THE HISTORY AND GOVERNMENT OF THIS STATE. WITHIN 10 DAYS
- 25 AFTER THE STATE ACADEMIC CONTENT STANDARDS ARE ADOPTED, THE
- 26 DEPARTMENT SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE STANDARDS TO ALL PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN
- 27 THIS STATE AND MAKE THE STANDARDS AVAILABLE TO THE PUBLIC ON THE

- 1 DEPARTMENT WEBSITE.
- 2 (C) AS PART OF THE PROCESS OF CONVERSION AWAY FROM THE COMMON
- 3 CORE STANDARDS, THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION, THE STATE
- 4 BOARD, THE DEPARTMENT, AND ANY OTHER STATE PUBLIC EMPLOYEE OR
- 5 AUTHORITY SHALL TAKE ALL STEPS NECESSARY TO TERMINATE AREAS OF
- 6 FEDERAL CONTROL OF THE MICHIGAN EDUCATIONAL PROCESS. THE
- 7 SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION, THE STATE BOARD, THE
- 8 DEPARTMENT, OR ANY OTHER STATE PUBLIC EMPLOYEE OR AUTHORITY SHALL
- 9 NOT ADOPT OR IMPLEMENT ANY NATIONAL OR MULTISTATE CONSORTIUM
- 10 STANDARD FROM ANY SOURCE, OR THE USE OF ANY ASSESSMENTS ALIGNED
- 11 WITH A NATIONAL OR MULTISTATE CONSORTIUM STANDARD, THAT CEDES
- 12 CONTROL OF MICHIGAN EDUCATIONAL STANDARDS IN ANY MANNER, INCLUDING,
- 13 BUT NOT LIMITED TO, MATHEMATICS STANDARDS, ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS
- 14 STANDARDS, THE NEXT GENERATION SCIENCE STANDARDS, HISTORY
- 15 STANDARDS, SOCIAL STUDIES STANDARDS, OR SEXUALITY STANDARDS. THIS
- 16 STATE SHALL RETAIN SOLE CONTROL OVER THE DEVELOPMENT,
- 17 ESTABLISHMENT, AND REVISION OF COURSE OF STUDY STANDARDS FOR GRADES
- 18 K TO 12. THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION, THE STATE BOARD,
- 19 THE DEPARTMENT, OR ANY OTHER STATE PUBLIC EMPLOYEE OR AUTHORITY
- 20 SHALL NOT JOIN ANY CONSORTIUM OR ANY OTHER ORGANIZATION IF
- 21 PARTICIPATION IN THAT CONSORTIUM OR ORGANIZATION WOULD CEDE ANY
- 22 MEASURE OF CONTROL OVER ANY ASPECT OF MICHIGAN PUBLIC EDUCATION TO
- 23 THAT CONSORTIUM OR ORGANIZATION.
- 24 (D) NOT EARLIER THAN 5 YEARS AFTER THE ADOPTION OF THE
- 25 STANDARDS UNDER SUBDIVISION (B), ADOPT NEW STATEWIDE ACADEMIC
- 26 CONTENT STANDARDS FOR EACH OF GRADES KINDERGARTEN TO 12 IN ENGLISH
- 27 LANGUAGE ARTS, MATHEMATICS, SCIENCE, AND SOCIAL STUDIES THAT ARE

- 1 DISTINCT FROM AND NOT DIRECTLY ALIGNED TO THE COMMON CORE STANDARDS
- 2 THAT WERE PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED BY THE STATE BOARD. THE NEW STATEWIDE
- 3 ACADEMIC CONTENT STANDARDS SHALL EMPHASIZE COHERENCE, FOCUS, AND
- 4 ESSENTIAL KNOWLEDGE AND SHALL HAVE EVIDENCE OF SUCCESSFUL
- 5 APPLICATION. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT IMPLEMENT NEW STATEWIDE
- 6 ACADEMIC CONTENT STANDARDS UNDER THIS SUBDIVISION UNTIL THE
- 7 PROPOSED STANDARDS ARE APPROVED BY BOTH HOUSES OF THE LEGISLATURE
- 8 BY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION. THE STANDING COMMITTEE HAVING
- 9 JURISDICTION OVER EDUCATION LEGISLATION IN EACH HOUSE SHALL CONDUCT
- 10 AT LEAST 1 PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED STANDARDS AND SHALL POST
- 11 NOTICE OF EACH PUBLIC HEARING AT LEAST 2 WEEKS BEFORE HOLDING THE
- 12 PUBLIC HEARING.
- 13 (2) WHEN THE STATE BOARD ADOPTS OR REVISES ACADEMIC CONTENT
- 14 STANDARDS UNDER THIS SECTION, THE STATE BOARD SHALL DEVELOP THOSE
- 15 STANDARDS INDEPENDENTLY AND NOT AS PART OF A MULTISTATE CONSORTIUM.
- 16 (3) THE BOARD OF EACH SCHOOL DISTRICT AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS
- 17 OF EACH PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY, CONSIDERING THE ACADEMIC CONTENT
- 18 STANDARDS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SECTION, SHALL DO ALL OF THE
- 19 FOLLOWING:
- 20 (A) ESTABLISH A FUNDAMENTAL ACADEMIC CURRICULUM FOR ITS PUPILS
- 21 AT THE ELEMENTARY, MIDDLE, AND SECONDARY SCHOOL LEVELS. THE
- 22 FUNDAMENTAL ACADEMIC CURRICULUM SHALL DEFINE ACADEMIC OBJECTIVES TO
- 23 BE ACHIEVED BY ALL PUPILS AND SHALL BE BASED UPON THE SCHOOL
- 24 DISTRICT'S EDUCATIONAL MISSION, LONG-RANGE PUPIL GOALS, AND PUPIL
- 25 PERFORMANCE OBJECTIVES. THE FUNDAMENTAL ACADEMIC CURRICULUM MAY
- 26 VARY FROM THE STATE ACADEMIC CONTENT STANDARDS ADOPTED UNDER THIS
- 27 SECTION.

- 1 (B) AFTER CONSULTING WITH TEACHERS AND SCHOOL BUILDING
- 2 ADMINISTRATORS, DETERMINE THE ALIGNED INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAM FOR
- 3 DELIVERING THE SCHOOL DISTRICT'S OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY'S
- 4 FUNDAMENTAL ACADEMIC CURRICULUM AND IDENTIFY THE COURSES AND
- 5 PROGRAMS IN WHICH THE FUNDAMENTAL ACADEMIC CURRICULUM WILL BE
- 6 TAUGHT.
- 7 (C) PROVIDE ADEQUATE TIME AND TRANSPARENCY FOR PUBLIC REVIEW
- 8 AND COMMENT ON THE ALIGNED INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS BY ALL INTERESTED
- 9 MEMBERS OF THE COMMUNITY BEFORE FINAL ADOPTION.
- 10 (4) THIS SECTION SHALL NOT BE CONSTRUED TO PROMOTE ANY
- 11 RELIGIOUS OR NONRELIGIOUS DOCTRINE, PROMOTE DISCRIMINATION FOR OR
- 12 AGAINST A PARTICULAR SET OF RELIGIOUS BELIEFS OR NONBELIEFS, OR
- 13 PROMOTE DISCRIMINATION FOR OR AGAINST RELIGION OR NONRELIGION.
- 14 (5) THIS SECTION DOES NOT REQUIRE ANY SCHOOL DISTRICT OR
- 15 PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY TO UTILIZE ALL OR ANY PART OF THE ACADEMIC
- 16 CONTENT STANDARDS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SECTION. THE STATE BOARD AND
- 17 THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT IMPOSE ANY FINANCIAL CONSEQUENCE ON A
- 18 SCHOOL DISTRICT OR PUBLIC SCHOOL ACADEMY THAT ADOPTS ACADEMIC
- 19 CONTENT STANDARDS DIFFERING FROM THOSE ADOPTED BY THIS STATE UNDER
- 20 THIS SECTION.
- 21 SEC. 1278F. (1) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT VALIDATED STATE
- 22 ASSESSMENTS OF PUPIL ACHIEVEMENT BASED ON THE ASSESSMENT USED IN
- 23 MASSACHUSETTS DURING THE 2008-2009 SCHOOL YEAR AND ALIGNED TO THE
- 24 ACADEMIC STANDARDS IN EFFECT IN MASSACHUSETTS DURING THE 2008-2009
- 25 SCHOOL YEAR. THESE ASSESSMENTS SHALL BE READY FOR USE BY THE FIRST
- 26 SPRING AFTER NEW STATEWIDE ACADEMIC CONTENT STANDARDS ARE ADOPTED
- 27 UNDER SECTION 1278E(1)(B). THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT REVISE THE

- 1 ASSESSMENTS UNDER THIS SUBSECTION AGAIN FOR A PERIOD OF AT LEAST 5
- 2 YEARS. THE NEW ASSESSMENTS ADOPTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION AND ALL
- 3 FUTURE ASSESSMENTS ADOPTED BY THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MEET ALL OF THE
- 4 FOLLOWING:
- 5 (A) SHALL NOT REQUIRE, BUT MAY USE, COMPUTER TECHNOLOGY.
- 6 (B) EACH YEAR, WITHIN 30 DAYS AFTER THE ASSESSMENT IS
- 7 ADMINISTERED, SHALL BE AVAILABLE ON THE DEPARTMENT WEBSITE FOR ALL
- 8 SCHOOL ADMINISTRATORS, TEACHERS, AND PARENTS TO REVIEW.
- 9 (C) SHALL NOT COLLECT ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 10 (i) DATA ABOUT THE VALUES, ATTITUDES, BELIEFS, AND PERSONALITY
- 11 TRAITS OF A PUPIL OR A PUPIL'S FAMILY.
- 12 (ii) MEDICAL, BEHAVIORAL, MENTAL, BIOMETRIC, OR PSYCHOMETRIC
- 13 DATA OF A PUPIL OR A PUPIL'S FAMILY.
- 14 (2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT IMPLEMENT AN ASSESSMENT DEVELOPED
- 15 UNDER THIS SECTION UNTIL THE PROPOSED ASSESSMENT IS APPROVED BY
- 16 BOTH HOUSES OF THE LEGISLATURE BY CONCURRENT RESOLUTION. THE
- 17 STANDING COMMITTEE HAVING JURISDICTION OVER EDUCATION LEGISLATION
- 18 IN EACH HOUSE SHALL CONDUCT AT LEAST 1 PUBLIC HEARING ON THE
- 19 PROPOSED ASSESSMENT AND SHALL POST NOTICE OF EACH PUBLIC HEARING AT
- 20 LEAST 2 WEEKS BEFORE HOLDING THE PUBLIC HEARING.
