A bill to amend 1979 PA 94, entitled
"The state school aid act of 1979,"

(MCL 388.1601 to 388.1896) by adding section 31e.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 31E. (1) FROM THE SCHOOL AID FUND MONEY APPROPRIATED IN
- 2 SECTION 11, THERE IS APPROPRIATED FOR 2016-2017 AN AMOUNT NOT TO
- 3 EXCEED \$14,000,000.00 FOR PAYMENTS UNDER THIS SECTION TO DISTRICTS
- 4 OPERATING EXPANDED LEARNING TIME PROGRAMS.
- 5 (2) A DISTRICT QUALIFIES FOR A PAYMENT UNDER THIS SECTION IF
- 6 THE DEPARTMENT DETERMINES THAT THE DISTRICT MEETS ALL OF THE
- 7 FOLLOWING:
- 8 (A) THE DISTRICT OPERATES AT LEAST 1 SCHOOL THAT ENROLLS AND
- 9 EDUCATES PUPILS IN SOME OR ALL OF GRADES K TO 8.
 - (B) MORE THAN 70% OF THE PUPILS ENROLLED IN THE DISTRICT MEET

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- 1 THE INCOME ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR THE FEDERAL FREE AND REDUCED
- 2 PRICE LUNCH PROGRAM.
- 3 (C) THE DISTRICT PROVIDES AT LEAST 1,200 HOURS OF PUPIL
- 4 INSTRUCTION FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR FOR PUPILS IN GRADES K TO 5 AND AT
- 5 LEAST 1,290 HOURS OF PUPIL INSTRUCTION FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR FOR
- 6 PUPILS IN GRADES 6 TO 8.
- 7 (D) THE DISTRICT AGREES TO SPEND THE ADDITIONAL INSTRUCTIONAL
- 8 TIME REQUIRED UNDER SUBDIVISION (C) ON AN APPROPRIATE MIX OF ALL OF
- 9 THE FOLLOWING:
- 10 (i) CORE ACADEMICS.
- 11 (ii) PROGRAMMING THAT BROADENS PUPILS' SKILLS AND EDUCATIONAL
- 12 OPPORTUNITIES, SUCH AS MUSIC, ART, ATHLETICS, HEALTH AND WELLNESS
- 13 PROGRAMS, PROJECT-BASED EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING, AND APPRENTICESHIPS.
- 14 (iii) ADDITIONAL TIME FOR TEACHER COLLABORATION AND
- 15 PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT.
- 16 (3) IF THERE ARE NOT SUFFICIENT FUNDS ALLOCATED UNDER THIS
- 17 SECTION TO FULLY FUND PAYMENTS TO QUALIFYING DISTRICTS, THE
- 18 DEPARTMENT MAY PRIORITIZE FUNDING THAT SUPPORTS PUPILS ENROLLED IN
- 19 GRADES 6 TO 8.
- 20 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect October
