A bill to amend 1970 PA 91, entitled "Child custody act of 1970,"

(MCL 722.21 to 722.31) by adding section 7d.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 7D. (1) IF A NONCUSTODIAL PARENT WHO HAS BEEN GRANTED
- 2 PARENTING TIME UNDER THIS ACT IS ON ACTIVE DUTY OUTSIDE OF THIS
- 3 STATE, THAT PARENT MAY PETITION THE COURT TO ALLOW HIS OR HER
- 4 FAMILY MEMBER TO FULFILL HIS OR HER PARENTING TIME AS ORDERED BY
- 5 THE COURT.
- 6 (2) IF A PETITION IS FILED UNDER SUBSECTION (1), THE COURT MAY
- 7 ENTER A TEMPORARY ORDER ALLOWING THE NONCUSTODIAL PARENT WHO IS ON
- 8 ACTIVE DUTY OUTSIDE OF THIS STATE TO ASSIGN HIS OR HER PARENTING
- 9 TIME TO HIS OR HER FAMILY MEMBER IF THERE IS CLEAR AND CONVINCING
- 10 EVIDENCE THAT IT IS IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE CHILD TO DO SO.

- 1 UPON THE NONCUSTODIAL PARENT'S RETURN TO THIS STATE, THE COURT
- 2 SHALL REINSTATE THE PARENTING TIME ORDER IN EFFECT IMMEDIATELY
- 3 PRECEDING THE PERIOD OF ACTIVE DUTY SERVED OUTSIDE OF THIS STATE.
- 4 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 5 after the date it is enacted into law.
