A bill to amend 1953 PA 232, entitled "Corrections code of 1953,"

(MCL 791.201 to 791.285) by adding section 8a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 8A. AS USED IN THIS ACT, "RECIDIVISM" MEANS THE REARREST,
- 2 RECONVICTION, AND REINCARCERATION IN PRISON OR JAIL OF AN
- 3 INDIVIDUAL WITHIN 3 AND 5 YEARS OF HIS OR HER RELEASE FROM
- 4 INCARCERATION, PLACEMENT ON PROBATION, OR CONVICTION, WHICHEVER IS
- 5 LATER, AND PROBATION AND PAROLE VIOLATIONS AS WELL AS MISDEMEANOR
- 6 AND FELONY CONVICTIONS, IF RECIDIVISM DATA REGARDING TECHNICAL
- 7 PROBATION AND PAROLE VIOLATIONS ARE COLLECTED AND MAINTAINED
- 8 SEPARATELY FROM DATA ON NEW FELONY OR MISDEMEANOR CONVICTIONS.
 - Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
