A bill to amend 1976 PA 399, entitled "Safe drinking water act,"

(MCL 325.1001 to 325.1023) by adding section 19a.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 SEC. 19A. (1) THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES RESPONSIBLE FOR
- 2 AN ACTIVE OR INACTIVE UNITED STATES MILITARY BASE THAT IS LOCATED
- 3 IN THIS STATE SHALL PROVIDE AN ALTERNATIVE WATER SUPPLY TO THE
- 4 OWNERS OF PRIVATE RESIDENTIAL WELLS IN THE VICINITY OF THE MILITARY
- 5 BASE IF ALL OF THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS ARE MET:
- 6 (A) THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES HAS ISSUED A
 - DRINKING WATER ADVISORY COVERING THE GEOGRAPHIC AREA IN THE
- 8 VICINITY OF THE MILITARY BASE.
- (B) THE SUBSTANCE THAT IS THE SUBJECT OF THE DRINKING WATER
- 10 ADVISORY IS A SUBSTANCE THAT IS OR WAS USED AT THE MILITARY BASE.

- 1 MILITARY BASE ACKNOWLEDGES THAT THE SUBSTANCE THAT IS THE SUBJECT

- 17 CODE, 1978 PA 368, MCL 333.1105, HAS PROVIDED AN ALTERNATIVE WATER
- 18 SUPPLY TO THE OWNERS OF THE RESIDENTIAL WELLS IN THE VICINITY OF
- 19 THE UNITED STATES MILITARY BASE IMPACTED BY A DRINKING WATER
- 20 ADVISORY, AND THE CONDITIONS OF SUBSECTION (1)(A), (B), AND (C)
- 21 HAVE BEEN MET, THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES RESPONSIBLE FOR THE
- 22 UNITED STATES MILITARY BASE SHALL REIMBURSE THE STATE OR POLITICAL
- 23 SUBDIVISION FOR THE COST OF PROVIDING THE ALTERNATIVE WATER SUPPLY.
- 24 (4) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- 25 (A) "ALTERNATIVE WATER SUPPLY" MEANS A LONG-TERM SUPPLY OF
- 26 POTABLE WATER FOR DRINKING WATER AND OTHER HOUSEHOLD PURPOSES, SUCH
- 27 AS CONNECTION TO A COMMUNITY SUPPLY, THAT DOES NOT CONTAIN THE

- 1 SUBSTANCE FOR WHICH AN ADVISORY WAS ISSUED AND THAT MEETS STATE
- 2 DRINKING WATER STANDARDS.
- 3 (B) "DRINKING WATER ADVISORY" MEANS AN ADVISORY ISSUED BY THE
- 4 DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES THAT CAUTIONS AGAINST USING
- 5 WATER FOR DRINKING OR OTHER HOUSEHOLD PURPOSES BECAUSE OF THE
- 6 PRESENCE OF A SUBSTANCE THAT IS OR MAY BE INJURIOUS TO HUMAN HEALTH
- 7 OR SAFETY.
