SENATE BILL No. 1056

September 7, 2016, Introduced by Senators O'BRIEN and MACGREGOR and referred to the Committee on Banking and Financial Institutions.

A bill to amend 2006 PA 250, entitled "Money transmission services act," by amending section 4 (MCL 487.1004).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

Sec. 4. This act does not apply to any of the following:

(a) The United States or a department, agency, or

- (a) The United States or a department, agency, or instrumentality of the United States.
- (b) Money transmission services **THAT ARE** provided by the United States postal service POSTAL SERVICE or by a contractor on behalf of the United States postal service.POSTAL SERVICE.
- (c) A state, county, city, or any other governmental subdivision of a state.
 - (d) A depository financial institution, office of an

- 26 (H) (g) A registered futures commission merchant under the

- 2 (I) (h)—A person that provides clearance or settlement
- 3 services under a registration as a clearing agency or an exemption
- 4 from registration granted under the federal securities laws, to the
- 5 extent of its operation as a provider under this subdivision.

- 7 provides processing, clearing, settlement, or other similar
- 8 services between or among persons excluded by UNDER this section in
- 9 connection with wire transfers, credit card transactions, debit
- 10 card transactions, stored value transactions, automated
- 11 clearinghouse transfers, or other similar funds transfers or
- 12 transactions.
- (K) (j) A person **THAT IS** registered as a securities broker-
- 14 dealer under federal or state securities laws, to the extent of its
- 15 operation as a registered broker-dealer.
- 16 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 17 after the date it is enacted into law.
