

## **SENATE BILL No. 1095**

September 21, 2016, Introduced by Senators PROOS, BRANDENBURG, HERTEL, HANSEN and ZORN and referred to the Committee on Commerce.

A bill entering into the interstate library compact; and for related purposes.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the
- 2 "interstate library compact".
- 3 Sec. 2. The interstate library compact is enacted into law and
- 4 entered into on behalf of this state with any state bordering on
- 5 Michigan that legally joins the compact in substantially the
- 6 following form:
- 7 INTERSTATE LIBRARY COMPACT
- 8 The contracting states agree that:
- 9 ARTICLE I--PURPOSE
- 10 Because the desire for the services provided by public libraries
- 11 transcends governmental boundaries and can be provided most

- 1 effectively by giving such services to communities of people
- 2 regardless of jurisdictional lines, it is the policy of the states
- 3 who are parties to this compact to co-operate and share their
- 4 responsibilities in providing joint and co-operative library
- 5 services in areas where the distribution of population makes the
- 6 provision of library service on an interstate basis the most
- 7 effective way to provide adequate and efficient services.
- 8 ARTICLE II--PROCEDURE
- 9 The appropriate officials and agencies of the party states or any
- 10 of their political subdivisions may, on behalf of said states or
- 11 political subdivisions, enter into agreements for the co-operative
- 12 or joint conduct of library services when they shall find that the
- 13 executions of agreements to that end as provided herein will
- 14 facilitate library services.
- 15 ARTICLE III--CONTENT
- 16 Any such agreement for the co-operative or joint establishment,
- 17 operation or use of library services, facilities, personnel,
- 18 equipment, materials or other items not excluded because of failure
- 19 to enumerate shall, as among the parties of the agreement: (1)
- 20 detail the specific nature of the services, facilities, properties
- 21 or personnel to which it is applicable; (2) provide for the
- 22 allocation of costs and other financial responsibilities; (3)
- 23 specify the respective rights, duties, obligations and liabilities;
- 24 (4) stipulate the terms and conditions for duration, renewal,
- 25 termination, abrogation, disposal of joint or common property, if

- 1 any, and all other matters which may be appropriate to the proper
- 2 effectuation and performance of said agreement.
- 3 ARTICLE IV--CONFLICT OF LAWS
- 4 Nothing in this compact or in any agreement entered into hereunder
- 5 shall be construed to supersede, alter, or otherwise impair any
- 6 obligation imposed on any public library by otherwise applicable
- 7 laws.
- 8 ARTICLE V--ADMINISTRATOR
- 9 Each state shall designate a compact administrator with whom copies
- 10 of all agreements to which his state or any subdivision thereof is
- 11 party shall be filed. The administrator shall have such powers as
- 12 may be conferred upon him by the laws of his state and may consult
- 13 and co-operate with the compact administrators of other party
- 14 states and take such steps as may effectuate the purposes of this
- 15 compact.
- 16 ARTICLE VI--EFFECTIVE DATE
- 17 This compact shall become operative immediately upon its enactment
- 18 by any state or between it and any other contiguous state or states
- 19 so enacting.
- 20 ARTICLE VII--RENUNCIATION
- 21 This compact shall continue in force and remain binding upon each
- 22 party state until 6 months after any such state has given notice of
- 23 repeal by the legislature. Such withdrawal shall not be construed

- 1 to relieve any party to an agreement authorized by Articles II and
- 2 III of the compact from the obligation of that agreement prior to
- 3 the end of its stipulated period of duration.
- 4 ARTICLE VIII--SEVERABILITY; CONSTRUCTION
- 5 The provisions of this compact shall be severable. It is intended
- 6 that the provisions of this compact be reasonably and liberally
- 7 construed.
