Sec. 654. (1) A board shall appoint an executive director to

serve as the chief executive officer of the fund. The executive director shall serve at the pleasure of the board. The executive director may employ staff and hire consultants as necessary with the approval of the board. The board shall determine compensation for the executive director and staff employed under this subsection and shall approve contracts under this subsection. THE COMPENSATION FOR THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL NOT EXCEED THE COMPENSATION SET FOR THE SENATE MAJORITY LEADER OR THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, WHICHEVER IS LESS, AS DETERMINED BY THE STATE
