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SENATE BILL No. 1142

October 20, 2016, Introduced by Senators KNOLLENBERG, MACGREGOR and MARLEAU and referred to the Committee on Regulatory Reform.

A bill to amend 1978 PA 368, entitled "Public health code,"

by amending section 20106 (MCL 333.20106), as amended by 2015 PA 104.

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- Sec. 20106. (1) "Health facility or agency", except as
 provided in section 20115, means:
 - (a) An ambulance operation, aircraft transport operation, nontransport prehospital life support operation, or medical first response service.
 - (b) A county medical care facility.
 - (c) A freestanding surgical outpatient facility.
 - (d) A health maintenance organization.
 - (e) A home for the aged.

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- 1 (f) A hospital.
- 2 (g) A nursing home.
- 3 (h) A hospice.
- 4 (i) A hospice residence.
- 5 (j) A facility or agency listed in subdivisions (a) to (g)
- 6 located in a university, college, or other educational institution.
- 7 (2) "Health maintenance organization" means that term as
- 8 defined in section 3501 of the insurance code of 1956, 1956 PA 218,
- 9 MCL 500.3501.
- 10 (3) "Home for the aged" means a supervised personal care
- 11 facility, other than a hotel, adult foster care facility, hospital,
- 12 nursing home, or county medical care facility, that provides,
- 13 THROUGH A SINGLE ENTITY OR COMMONLY OWNED AND CONTROLLED ENTITIES,
- 14 room, board, and supervised personal care to 21 or more unrelated,
- 15 nontransient, individuals 60 years of age or older. Home for the
- 16 aged includes a supervised personal care facility for 20 or fewer
- 17 individuals 60 years of age or older if the facility is operated BY
- 18 A SINGLE ENTITY OR COMMONLY OWNED AND CONTROLLED ENTITIES in
- 19 conjunction with and as a distinct part of a licensed nursing home.
- 20 Home for the aged does not include an area excluded from this
- 21 definition by section $\frac{17(3)}{17}$ of the continuing care community
- 22 disclosure act, 2014 PA 448, MCL 554.917.
- 23 (4) "Hospice" means a health care program that provides a
- 24 coordinated set of services rendered at home or in outpatient or
- 25 institutional settings for individuals suffering from a disease or
- 26 condition with a terminal prognosis.
- 27 (5) "Hospital" means a facility offering inpatient, overnight

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- 1 care, and services for observation, diagnosis, and active treatment
- 2 of an individual with a medical, surgical, obstetric, chronic, or
- 3 rehabilitative condition requiring the daily direction or
- 4 supervision of a physician. Hospital does not include a mental
- 5 health hospital licensed or operated by the department of community
- 6 health AND HUMAN SERVICES or a hospital operated by the department
- 7 of corrections.
- 8 (6) "Hospital long-term care unit" means a nursing care
- 9 facility, owned and operated by and as part of a hospital,
- 10 providing organized nursing care and medical treatment to 7 or more
- 11 unrelated individuals suffering or recovering from illness, injury,
- 12 or infirmity.
- 13 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- 14 after the date it is enacted into law.

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
