A bill to amend 2008 PA 546, entitled

"Sexual assault victims' medical forensic intervention and treatment act,"

by amending section 5 (MCL 400.1535).

THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 5. (1) Money shall not be expended from the sexual
- 2 assault victims' medical forensic intervention and treatment fund
- 3 created in section 3 for the first year after the effective date of
- 4 this act. Beginning 2 years after the effective date of this act,
- 5 the THE board may expend money from the fund, as appropriated.
- 6 Money in the fund shall be expended only as follows:
