HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION II

April 26, 2016, Introduced by Reps. A joint resolution proposing an amendment to the state constitution of 1963, by amending section 10 of article IV, to prohibit offices of members of the legislature from being located in the same building as a lobbyist or lobbyist agent.

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the state of Michigan, That the following amendment to the state constitution of 1963, to prohibit offices of members of the legislature from being located in the same building as a lobbyist or lobbyist agent, is proposed, agreed to, and submitted to the people of the state:

ARTICLE IV

Sec. 10. (1) No A member of the legislature nor OR any state officer shall NOT be interested directly or indirectly in any
