## ENROLLED SENATE BILL No. 492

AN ACT to amend 1974 PA 269, entitled "An act to regulate the offer, sale, and purchase of franchises; to prohibit fraudulent practices in relation thereto; to prohibit pyramid and chain promotions; to impose regulatory duties upon certain state departments and agencies; and to provide penalties," (MCL 445.1501 to 445.1546) by adding section 4b.

The People of the State of Michigan enact:

Sec. 4b. To the extent allocation of employer responsibilities between the franchisor and franchisee is permitted by law, the franchisee shall be considered the sole employer of workers for whom it provides a benefit plan or pays wages except as otherwise specifically provided in the franchise agreement.

Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect $90$	0 days after the date it is enacted into law.
