Whereas, The members of this legislative body are proud to commend and thank Representative Amanda Price, as she brings to a close six years of distinguished service to the Michigan House of Representatives. She has been a valuable colleague and a champion for the Eighty-ninth District, and we wish her well in her future endeavors; and

Whereas, Amanda Price attended Michigan State University, the Institute for Paralegal Training, and Western Michigan University, with an interest in public affairs and serving the public good. She served as a public affairs manager, Park Township trustee and supervisor, and legislative aide to Senator Patty Birkholz. Her leadership skills were honed in the Michigan Political Leadership Program and as a Council of State Governments Bowhay Institute Legislative Leadership Fellow.
