## **SUMMARY:**

Senate Bill 981 would amend the Carnival-Amusement Safety Act to require the Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (LARA) to hire or retain an individual as the direct supervisor of inspectors.

LARA currently <u>may</u> hire inspectors to inspect carnival-amusement rides. The bill would instead <u>require</u> LARA to hire inspectors, as well as an individual to supervise the inspectors who LARA determines is qualified in engineering and training.

The act currently requires the chief carnival-amusement ride inspector to be licensed in Michigan as a professional engineer. The bill would eliminate this language and instead allow LARA to decide which inspectors are sufficiently qualified in engineering and training to act as the direct supervisor.
