## **SUMMARY:**

House Bill 6484 would amend the Insurance Code by adding Section 3136 to create tort liability for property damage arising from a motor vehicle accident under certain circumstances.

The new section would specify that, in addition to tort liability for certain noneconomic loss as described in Section 3135 of the Code,<sup>1</sup> tort liability would also apply to damage to tangible property arising from one accident in excess of the limit specified in Section 3121 of the Code<sup>2</sup> (currently \$1.0 million) for which liability insurance required by federal statute or regulation is in effect. The exception provided would be limited to the amount of the applicable limit under the insurance policy in effect less the limit under Section 3121 or \$4.0 million in excess of that limit, whichever is less.
