House Bills 4950 and 5047 (as reported without amendment)

CONTENT

<u>House Bill 4950</u> would amend the Income Tax Act to exempt health maintenance organizations (HMOs) authorized under Chapter 35 of the Insurance Code from the tax imposed on insurance companies.

<u>House Bill 5047</u> would amend the Income Tax Act to exclude from the definition of "insurance company" an HMO authorized under Chapter 35 of the Insurance Code.

Each bill would be retroactive and effective for tax years beginning on and after January 1, 2016.
