## HOUSE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 19

A bill to amend 1939 PA 280, entitled "The social welfare act,"

by amending section 10b (MCL 400.10b), as amended by 2011 PA 198.

## THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF MICHIGAN ENACT:

- 1 Sec. 10b. (1) Subject to subsection  $\frac{(2)}{(3)}$  and except as
- 2 provided in subsection (4), (5), the department shall not grant
- 3 public CASH assistance under this act to an individual if the
- 4 department receives information described in PROVIDED UNDER section
- 5 10a that the individual is subject to arrest under an outstanding
- 6 warrant arising from a felony charge against that individual in
- 7 this or any other jurisdiction. THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT GRANT FOOD
- 8 ASSISTANCE TO AN INDIVIDUAL IF THE INDIVIDUAL HAS AN OUTSTANDING
- 9 FELONY WARRANT AND LAW ENFORCEMENT IS ACTIVELY SEEKING THE
- 10 INDIVIDUAL. This subsection does not affect the eligibility for

- 1 assistance of other members of the individual's household. An
- 2 individual described in this subsection is eligible for CASH
- 3 assistance when he or she is no longer subject to arrest under an
- 4 outstanding warrant as described in this section AND LAW
- 5 ENFORCEMENT IS NOT ACTIVELY SEEKING THE INDIVIDUAL.
- 6 (2) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (3), THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT GRANT
- 7 CASH ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS ACT TO AN INDIVIDUAL IF THE DEPARTMENT
- 8 RECEIVES INFORMATION UNDER SECTION 84 OF THE CORRECTIONS CODE OF
- 9 1953, 1953 PA 232, MCL 791.284, THAT THE INDIVIDUAL HAS ABSCONDED
- 10 FROM SUPERVISION UNDER THAT ACT. SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (3), THE
- 11 DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT GRANT FOOD ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS ACT TO AN
- 12 INDIVIDUAL IF THE DEPARTMENT RECEIVES INFORMATION UNDER SECTION 84
- 13 OF THE CORRECTIONS CODE OF 1953, 1953 PA 232, MCL 791.284, THAT THE
- 14 INDIVIDUAL HAS ABSCONDED FROM SUPERVISION UNDER THAT ACT AND THAT
- 15 LAW ENFORCEMENT OR THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS IS ACTIVELY
- 16 SEEKING THE INDIVIDUAL.
- 17 (3) (2) If federal approval is required in order to prevent
- 18 the loss of federal reimbursement as a result of the application of
- 19 this section to a recipient receiving family independence PROGRAM
- 20 assistance or food stamps, ASSISTANCE, the department shall
- 21 promptly take any action necessary to obtain federal approval. In
- 22 the absence of any necessary federal approval, the department shall
- 23 apply this section only to recipients of state family assistance
- 24 and state disability assistance.
- 25 (4) (3) Upon implementation by the department under section
- 26 10c, not later than July 1, 2013, the THE department director or
- 27 his or her designee shall review information provided by the

- 1 department of state police under section 4 of the C.J.I.S. policy
- 2 council act, 1974 PA 163, MCL 28.214, to determine if public CASH
- 3 assistance OR FOOD ASSISTANCE recipients or applicants are subject
- 4 to arrest under an outstanding warrant as described in section 10a.
- 5 THE DEPARTMENT DIRECTOR OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE SHALL REVIEW
- 6 INFORMATION PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS UNDER SECTION
- 7 84 OF THE CORRECTIONS CODE OF 1953, 1953 PA 232, MCL 791.284, TO
- 8 DETERMINE IF CASH ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS OR APPLICANTS ARE SUBJECT
- 9 TO A WARRANT FOR ABSCONDING. THE DEPARTMENT DIRECTOR OR HIS OR HER
- 10 DESIGNEE SHALL REVIEW INFORMATION PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF
- 11 CORRECTIONS UNDER SECTION 84 OF THE CORRECTIONS CODE OF 1953, 1953
- 12 PA 232, MCL 791.284, TO DETERMINE IF FOOD ASSISTANCE RECIPIENTS OR
- 13 APPLICANTS ARE SUBJECT TO A WARRANT FOR ABSCONDING AND IF LAW
- 14 ENFORCEMENT IS ACTIVELY SEEKING THE RECIPIENTS OR APPLICANTS.
- 15 (5) (4) Upon implementation by the department under section
- 16 10c, not later than July 1, 2013, and subject SUBJECT to subsection
- 17  $\frac{(2)}{(3)}$  and except as provided in subsection (1), the department
- 18 shall not grant public-CASH assistance OR FOOD ASSISTANCE under
- 19 this act to an individual if the department receives information
- 20 from the department of state police as provided in subsection (3)
- 21 (4) that the individual is subject to an arrest under an
- 22 outstanding warrant described in section 10a. SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION
- 23 (3), THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT GRANT CASH ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS ACT
- 24 TO AN INDIVIDUAL IF THE DEPARTMENT RECEIVES INFORMATION FROM THE
- 25 DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS THAT THE INDIVIDUAL HAS ABSCONDED FROM
- 26 SUPERVISION. SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (3), THE DEPARTMENT SHALL NOT
- 27 GRANT FOOD ASSISTANCE UNDER THIS ACT TO AN INDIVIDUAL IF THE

- DEPARTMENT RECEIVES INFORMATION FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS 1
- 2 THAT THE INDIVIDUAL HAS ABSCONDED FROM SUPERVISION AND LAW
- ENFORCEMENT IS ACTIVELY SEEKING THE INDIVIDUAL. 3
- (6) AS USED IN THIS SECTION:
- (A) "ABSCOND" AND "ACTIVELY SEEKING" MEAN THOSE TERMS AS 5
- DEFINED IN SECTION 84 OF THE CORRECTIONS CODE OF 1953, 1953 PA 232,
- MCL 791,284. 7
- (B) "CASH ASSISTANCE" MEANS CASH BENEFITS PROVIDED UNDER THE 8
- FAMILY INDEPENDENCE PROGRAM, THE REFUGEE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM, OR
- STATE DISABILITY ASSISTANCE. 10
- 11 (C) "FOOD ASSISTANCE" MEANS THE FOOD BENEFITS PROVIDED UNDER
- 12 THE FOOD ASSISTANCE PROGRAM ADMINISTERED UNDER THIS ACT.
- 13 Enacting section 1. This amendatory act takes effect 90 days
- after the date it is enacted into law. 14
- Enacting section 2. This amendatory act does not take effect 15
- 16 unless Senate Bill No. 18 of the 99th Legislature is enacted into
- 17 law.
